Learn Ezekiel 36:26a.

Thought for the week:

God can make my sad and hard times new and good again.

Ezekiel was one of the major prophets in the Bible. God gave him messages to share with His people. God's people had split into two groups—Israel and Judah. But God had a plan! He would bring them back together again as one nation.

The Israelites felt sad and alone. But God wanted His people to know He had not forgotten them. He could make their nation strong again. 
