#### NICENE CREED, PART SIX

Leader: We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, Of all things visible and invisible. And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, begotten of his Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father; by whom all things were made; who for us and for our salvation came down from heaven, and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary, and was made man; and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate; he suffered and was buried; the third day he rose again according to the Scriptures, and ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he shall come again, with glory, to judge both the living and the dead; whose kingdom shall have no end. # WELCOME AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

#### SERMON TEXT

The public reading of the Scriptures reminds us of the truth that can only be found in God's Word.

<sup>1</sup> In the first year of Darius, the son of Ahasuerus, a Mede by birth, who was made kingover the Chaldean kingdom—<sup>2</sup>in the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, understood from the books according to the word of the Lord to the prophet Jeremiah that the number of years for the desolation of Jerusalem would be seventy. <sup>3</sup>So I turned my attention to the Lord God to seek him by prayer and petitions, with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes. <sup>4</sup>I prayed to the LORD my God and confessed: 'Ah, Lord—the great and awe-inspiring God who keeps his commands—<sup>5</sup>we have sinned, done wrong, acted wickedly, rebelled, and turned away from your commands and ordinances. <sup>6</sup>We have not listened to your servants the prophets, who spoke in your name to our kings, leaders, ancestors, and all the people of the land....<sup>18</sup>Listen closely, my God, and hear. Open your eyes and see our desolations and the city that bears your name. For we are not presenting our petitions before you based on our righteous acts, but based on your abundant compassion. <sup>19</sup> Lord, hear! Lord, forgive! Lord, listen and act! My God, for your own sake, do not delay, because your city and your people bear your name. <sup>20</sup> While I was speaking, praying, confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my petition before the Lord my God concerning the holy mountain of my God — <sup>21</sup>while I was praying, Gabriel, the man I had seen in the first vision, reached me in my extreme weariness, about the time of the evening offering. <sup>22</sup>He gave me this explanation: 'Daniel, I've come now to give you understanding. <sup>23</sup>At the beginning of your petitions an answer went out, and I have come to give it, for you are treasured by God. So consider

the message and understand the vision: <sup>24</sup>Seventy weeks are decreed about your people and your holy city—to bring the rebellion to an end, to put a stop to sin, to atone for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most holy place. <sup>25</sup>Know and understand this: from the issuing of the decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until an Anointed One, the ruler, will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks. It will be rebuilt with a plaza and a moat, but in difficult times. <sup>26</sup>After those sixty-two weeks the Anointed One will be cut off and will have nothing."
