OLD TESTAMENT READING

Leader: ¹Naaman, commander of the army for the king of Aram, was a man important to his master and highly regarded because through him, the Lord had given victory to Aram. The man was a valiant warrior, but he had a skin disease. ²Aram had gone on raids and brought back from the land of Israel a young girl who served Naaman's wife. ³She said to her mistress, 'If only my master were with the prophet who is in Samaria, he would cure him of his skin disease'... 7When the king of Israel read the letter, he tore his clothes and asked, 'Am I God, killing and giving life, that this man expects me to cure a man of his skin disease? Recognize that he is only picking a fight with me.' ®When Elisha the man of God heard that the king of Israel had torn his clothes, he sent a message to the king: 'Why have you torn your clothes? Have him come to me, and he will know there is a prophet in Israel.' 9So Naaman came with his horses and chariots and stood at the door of Elisha's house. ¹¹Then Elisha sent him a messenger, who said, 'Go wash seven times in the Jordan and your skin will be restored and you will be clean.' ¹¹ But Naaman got angry and left, saying, 'I was telling myself: He will surely come out, stand and call on the name of the Lord his God, and wave his hand over the place and cure the skin disease. ¹²Aren't Abana and Pharpar, the rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? Couldn't I wash in them and be clean?' So he turned and left in a rage. ¹³But his servants approached and said to him, 'My father, if the prophet had told you to do some great thing, would you not have done it? How much more should you do it when he only tells you, 'Wash and be clean?'"

People: ¹⁴So Naaman went down and dipped himself in the Jordan seven times, according to the command of the man of God. Then his skin was restored and became like the skin of a small boy, and he was clean. ¹⁵Then Naaman and his whole company went back to the man of God, stood before him, and declared, 'I know there's no God in the whole world except in Israel. Therefore, please accept a gift from your servant.' (2 Kings 5:1-3, 7-15)

SERMON TEXT

The public reading of the Scriptures reminds us of the truth that can only be found in God's Word.

"1The Lord said to Samuel, 'How long are you going to mourn for Saul, since I have rejected him as king over Israel? Fill your horn with oil and go. I am sending you to Jesse of Bethlehem because I have selected for myself a king from his sons.' ²Samuel asked, 'How can I go? Saul will hear about it and kill me!' The Lord answered, 'Take a young cow with you and say, 'I have come to sacrifice to the Lord.' ³Then invite Jesse to the sacrifice, and I will let you know what you are to do. You are to anoint for me the one I indicate to you.' ⁴ Samuel did what the Lord directed and went to Bethlehem. When the elders of the town met him, they trembled and asked, 'Do you come in peace?' ⁵In peace,' he replied. 'I've come to sacrifice to the Lord. Consecrate yourselves and come with me to the sacrifice.' Then he consecrated Jesse and his sons and invited them to the sacrifice. ⁶When they arrived, Samuel saw Eliab and said, 'Certainly the Lord's anointed one is here before him.' ⁷But the Lord said to Samuel, 'Do not look at his appearance or his stature because I have rejected him. Humans do not see what the Lord sees, for humans see what is visible, but the Lord sees the heart.' ⁸Jesse called Abinadab and presented him to Samuel. 'The Lord hasn't chosen this one either,' Samuel said. ⁹Then Jesse presented Shammah, but Samuel said, 'The Lord hasn't chosen this one either,' ¹⁰After Jesse presented seven of his sons to him, Samuel told Jesse, 'The Lord hasn't chosen any of these.' ¹¹Samuel asked him, 'Are these all the sons you have?' 'There is still the youngest,' he answered, 'but right now he's tending the sheep.' Samuel told Jesse, 'Send for him. We won't sit down to eat until he gets here.' ¹²So Jesse sent for him. He had beautiful eyes and a healthy, handsome appearance. Then the Lord said, 'Anoint him, for he is the one.' ¹³So Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the presence of his brothers, and the Spirit of the Lord came powerfully on David from that day forward.
