Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- What’s something you learned in school that you still use today?

Start thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- Which part of this message was most impactful for you and why?
- How do you typically think about the relationship between science and the Bible?
- Read **Revelation 22:13**. When you consider science and the Bible as being “both/and” instead of “either/or,” what thoughts and feelings come up?

Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- Share about an experience that required you to fully trust God, even if you still had questions. How was your faith impacted during that time?
- What truth about Jesus can you remember when you have doubts and questions? How might that truth help you sustain a growing, maturing faith?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

Father, thank You for helping us see the relationship between science and Your Word. We choose to trust in You, even when we don’t have all the answers. Please use our questions to build our faith and bring us closer to You. In Jesus’ name, amen.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- Spend time thinking about the truths of Jesus and your personal experiences with Jesus. Write these truths out, and put them in a place where you’ll see them regularly.
