## TALK IT OVER

### Key Scriptures

<sup>8</sup>God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. <sup>9</sup>Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. <sup>10</sup>For we are God's masterpiece. ### Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- What's something that you feel confident doing?
- What's something that you are terrified of doing?

### Start thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- Which part of this message was most impactful for you and why?
- Read **Ephesians 2:10**. What would look different in your life if you lived like this verse was true of you?
- In the message Pastor Lane said, "If God didn't want to use you, the devil wouldn't be fighting so hard against you." How has the enemy attacked you and your self-worth in an attempt to stop you from using your gifts to serve God and His church?

### Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- How often do you doubt yourself and your abilities? What truths about God do you need to remember when you're having doubts about yourself?
- Talk about an insecurity or failure that you've struggled with. In what ways could God use that experience for His glory?
- At the very end of the message Pastor Lane said that doubting ourselves is really doubting God. How do you respond to that thought? How could that thought set you free from doubt?

### Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

*Father, thank You for using the overlooked, the insecure, and our failures for Your glory. Please help us remember that we are created by You, in Your image. When the world tells us that we can't, we ask that You would remind us that You specialize in using people like us to accomplish the impossible. In Jesus' name, amen.*

### Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- Ask God how you can use your gifts and talents to serve God and his church. Reach out to one of our Pastor's and have a conversation about how you can serve on the weekends or with one of our local missions organizations.
- In prayer, confess to God the things other people have said about you, the things you have believed about you and ask Him to reveal how He thinks about you. Write those things down so you can look at them the next time you are struggling with insecurity.
