POINT 9 - Jesus was Supernaturally Confirmed to be God in Human Flesh

Reviewing Miraculous Confirmation

1. What is a miracle?

Divine intervention into the natural world that produces an unusual event that would not have occurred by natural laws.

- 2. Such events can then be used to confirm a message from God.
 - a. OT Examples
 - i. Exodus 4:1-5
 - ii. 1 Kings 18:36
 - b. NT Examples
 - i. Mark 2:10-11
 - ii. Luke 7:20-22

5 Criteria for Miraculous Confirmation

- 1. Supernatural (No anomalies, no magic, no providential acts, no psychosomatic cures)
 - a. Authenticity John 11, Matthew 14
- 2. Multiple miracles
 - a. Deuteronomy 17:6, "the mouth of two or three witnesses"
 - b. Gospel record provides over 50 miracles that Jesus did
- 3. Truth claim
 - a. John 3:2, Matthew 9:2-7, Hebrews 2:3-4, John 20:30-31
- 4. Predictive Element
 - a. Nearly 100 predictions of the first coming of the Messiah in the OT
 - i. Genesis 3, 4, 9, 12, 26, 49, 2 Samuel 7, Jeremiah 23, Isaiah 7, Micah 5, Isaiah 40, Isaiah 53, Daniel 9, Psalm 2, 16
 - ii. Isaiah 53:2-12 alone has roughly 20 predictions
- 5. Unique
 - a. Supernatural, multiple, predictive, and connected with His truth claims.
 - b. No other religion has contemporary, eye-witnessed based records
 - c. Unique convergence of miraculous confirmation
 - i. Supernatural predictions about Jesus
 - ii. Jesus lived a sinless and supernatural life
 - iii. Jesus predicted and accomplished His own resurrection

Alleged supernatural events of other religions & Response

- ➤ Miracle claims of Judaism
 - o Biblical Judaism vs Post-Biblical Judaism
 - Biblical Judaism is the parent of Biblical Christianity
 - Post-Biblical Judaism (Rejects Jesus as Messiah)
 - No miracles to support their claims
 - No central figure
 - o One example: cow gave birth to a lamb
 - No reliable source
 - No Messianic truth claim connected with it.
 - Contrary to God's ordained order (Genesis 1:24)
- ➤ Other non-Christian religions
- Miracle claims about Buddha
- ➤ Miracle claims about Hare Krishna (Hinduism)
- Miracle claims for Apollonius of Tyana
- Miracle claims for Muhammad
 - o Miracle of the Qur'an is Muhammad's miracle

Final Thoughts

- Norm Geisler points out in conclusion, that there should be no ultimate implication taken that God, who loves all people of all religions could not or would not do an occasional miracle, should he deem it part of His "goodness that leads to repentance" (Romans 2:4)
- ➤ With the fulfillment of OT prophesies, the life lived of performing miracles, and the predictive and accomplished/witnessed nature of the resurrection, Christ is the Christ, and Christ alone, is confirmed as almighty God in human flesh.
- > The central claim of Christianity is true.
- > The opposing claims are false.
- > Iesus Christ of Nazareth is God.

If Jesus is not God, then there is no Christianity, and we who worship Him are nothing more than idolaters. Conversely, if He is God, those who say He was merely a good man, or even the best of men, are blasphemers. More serious still, if He is not God, then He is a blasphemer in the fullest sense of the word. If He is not God, He is not even good." J. Oswald Sanders

The deity of Christ is the key doctrine of the scriptures. Reject it, and the Bible becomes a jumble of words without any unifying theme. Accept it, and the Bible becomes an intelligible and ordered revelation of God in the person of Jesus Christ." J. Oswald Sanders

1.	Why God cannot Err
	A. He knows and, so, He can't be wrong about
	(Psa. 147:5; Rom. 11:33).
	B. He must act and speak in accord with His nature (Heb. 6:17, Mal 3:6).
	C. Hence, He cannot utter
	(Heb 6:18, Titus 1:2, John 17:17, Rom 3:4, 2 Tim 2:13, James 1:17)
2.	Why Jesus cannot Err
	A. The Logical Reason
	1. God err.
	2. Jesus is God.
	3. Hence, Jesus err.
	B. The Moral Reason
	1. Jesus is morally
	2. A morally perfect being cannot (intentionally err)
	3. Therefore, Jesus cannot deceive anyone about what He
	4. Hence, Jesus cannot deceive anyone about anything He
	(Special note undergirding this reason: Christ's Character and Nature)
