1. Introduction to Spiritual Beings

The Bible includes spiritual beings as key players, not just humans and God.

Genesis 1 sets the stage with a _____ order:

1. Days 1–3: Forming (light/dark, sky/waters, land/vegetation).
2. Days 4–6: Filling (sun/moon, birds/fish, animals/humans).

Terms like “tohu va-vohu” (_____) describe chaos that God brings into order.

Spiritual beings are a normal part of the biblical worldview.

2. Elohim

“Elohim” is a _____ term used for God, but also other spiritual beings.

It’s a _____, not a name.

1. El: “Strong one” – title for a deity.
2. Eloah: Singular form of Elohim.
3. Elohim: Plural, can refer to gods or God depending on context.

Example: “You shall have no other elohim before me” – shows that other gods exist but should not be worshipped.

3. The Divine Council

God's heavenly staff team – also called “_____”
“holy ones,” or “host of heaven.”

Seen in places like Psalm 82, 1 Kings 22, and Isaiah 6.

They serve, advise, and sometimes rebel against God
(see Genesis 3, 6, and 11).

Humans and divine beings are both tasked with ruling—
one on Earth, the other in Heaven.

4. Angels and Cherubim

Angels (Hebrew mal'ak, Greek angelos) =
“_____” Can be human or spiritual.

Biblical angels often look human, not _____.

Cherubim are not angels. They are throne guardians, seen
only in visions (e.g., Ezekiel, Isaiah, Revelation).

Cherubim guard sacred space, like Eden and the Ark of
the Covenant.
