There are 3 key things to focus on today and let sink into your spirit.

1. He is Faithful to keep His promises
2. His promises are for you!
3. To partake, we must pursue.

1) HE PROMISES TO ALWAYS LOVE YOU

If a man has a hundred sheep and one of them gets lost, what will he do? Won't he leave the ninety nine others in the wilderness and go to search for the one that is lost until he finds it?

—Luke 15:4 NLT

2) HE PROMISES WE WILL KNOW HIS VOICE

My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.

—John 10:27

We are his people and his sheep. His sheep know His voice

3) HE PROMISES TO GIVE HIS PEOPLE PEACE

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.

Shalom- completeness, soundness (of body) ,fullness of peace(quiet, tranquility, contentment.

What consumes your mind controls your life?

Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise. ...Then the God of peace will be with you.

—*Philippians 4:8-9 NLT*

True peace is found in the presence of God.

4) HE PROMISES TO GIVE US REST

Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light.

—*Matthew 11:28-30*

Rest from WORKING for atonement.

5) HE PROMISES TO BE WITH YOU ALWAYS (MATTHEW 28:19-20)

Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. 20 Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.

—Matthew 28:19-20
