Discussion Questions

3. Grace That Governs the Mind

Romans 12:2 (NLT)

How does letting the Spirit “change the way you think” build an unshakeable life? What’s one thought pattern God has been transforming in you lately?

4. Living by the Spirit vs. the Flesh

Galatians 5:22–25 (NLT)

“But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control...”
How does living by these fruits make us steady when the world shakes?

5. Grace That Extends Through Us

If God’s mercy pauses are about giving others space to respond, how can we mirror that mercy toward people in our own lives who frustrate or fail us?
