THE SIMPLE VISION FRAME

We are shaping our life together around three postures, not programs:

IN COMMUNITY • IN FAMILY • IN EXPECTATION

Just as our bodies have many parts and each part has a special function, so it is with Christ's body. We are many parts of one body, and we all belong to each other.

—Romans 12:4–5

“He makes the whole body fit together perfectly. As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole body is healthy and growing and full of love.”

—Ephesians 4:16

1. IN COMMUNITY

Community is where faith stops being theoretical.

*Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise. Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, **especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.***

—Hebrews 10:24–25

We believe:

- Faith grows best when it's shared
- People grow faster when they're known
- Church is practiced, not consumed

Outward Community: IN COMMUNITY doesn't stop at the church doors.

You are the light of the world—like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden. No one lights a lamp and then puts it under a basket. Instead, a lamp is placed on a stand, where it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father.

—Matthew 5:14–16

Community is where faith is strengthened — and where mission begins.**

2. IN FAMILY

Church is not a crowd. - It's a family.

So now you Gentiles are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God's holy people. You are members of God's family. Together, we are his house, built on the foundation of the apostles and the prophets. And the cornerstone is Christ Jesus himself.

Let each generation tell its children of your mighty acts; let them proclaim your power.

3. IN EXPECTATION
