## 1. The Wind Has a Pattern

*“The wind blows wherever it wants. Just as you can hear the wind but can't tell where it comes from or where it is going, so you can't explain how people are born of the Spirit.”*

## 2. The Wind Has a Sound

## 3. The Wind Has Power

*“And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability.”*

## **4. The Wind Is Breath — Personal and Life-Giving**

*“Then the Lord God formed the man from the dust of the ground. He breathed the breath of life into the man’s nostrils, and the man became a living person.”*

*—Genesis 2:7 NLT*

## **NAVIGATE**

### **Short Confession:**

Holy Spirit, fill my life with movement, momentum, and power. I raise my sails to catch Your direction.

## **1. The Promise of the Helper (Postured)**

*“But in fact, it is best for you that I go away, because if I don’t, the Advocate won’t come. If I do go away, then I will send him to you.”*

—John 16:7 NLT

## **2. The Choice to Raise Your Sails (Positioned)**

*“Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit. So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace.”*

—Romans 8:5–6 NLT

## **3. Walk in Step with the Spirit (Submitted)**

*“Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit’s leading in every part of our lives.”*

—Galatians 5:25 NLT

## **4. Cut the Ropes Holding You Back (Aligned)**

- Unforgiveness, fear, pride, or doubt can anchor you down.
- You must untie from the dock if you want to move into purpose.
- God’s wind will not move you unless you’re willing to let go.
