Our Choice

The Word longs for us to make moment-by-moment choices that result in life (joy).

Nothing supernatural can happen to us or through us without us living in the wonder of the Father.

The Purpose of the Holy Spirit

“And I will send you the Divine Encourager from the very presence of my Father. He will come to you, the Spirit of

Truth, emanating from the Father, and he will speak to you about me.

—*John 15:26 (TPT)*

THE MOMENT OF YOUR SALVATION (NATURAL)

Belief is the beginning of the life of the supernatural!

He baptizes us in Jesus (introduces - makes believe possible)

“I Do!”

THE MOMENTS OF YOUR LIFE (SUPERNATURAL)

Jesus baptizes us into the Holy Spirit (introduces us to the supernatural)

The baptism of the Holy Spirit (the moment you admit that you cannot believe in Jesus on your own in a way that fully expresses all the Word means and achieves).

“I Doing!”

ONGOING MOMENTS OF BELIEF

It's not just about your salvation; it's about your supernatural impact in a natural world that desperately needs God!

BELIEF IN JESUS (Relationship with God)

BELIEF IN EACH OTHER (Church)

BELIEF IN YOURSELF (Gifts)

Our current dispensation is not at the foot of the cross. We live in a supernatural period set aside for us to become the complete revelation of Jesus to the world.

Jesus is the complete revelation of God to man.

The Holy Spirit enables the church to fully express Jesus to the world.

Spirit enables the intentions of the Father and the reality of the Word (supernatural) to become His full expression in the natural.

The Process of the Holy Spirit - POWER Grid

Creation of Natural: Spirit -> Word -> Spirit

SPIRIT

The earth was formless and empty, and darkness covered the deep waters. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters.

—Genesis 1:2-3

WORD

Then God said, “Let there be light,” and there was light.

—Genesis 1:2-3

SPIRIT

Then the Lord God formed the man from the dust of the ground. He breathed the breath of life into the man’s nostrils, and the man became a living person.

—Genesis 2:7

New Creation (Supernatural): Spirit ->Word ->Spirit

SPIRIT

“Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, ‘This is the way; walk in it.’”

—Isaiah 30:21

WORD

So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son.

—John 1:14 NLT

SPIRIT

But it is actually best for you that I go away, because if I don't, the Counselor won't come. If I do go away, he will come because I will send him to you.

—John 16:7

Counselor: parakletos (par-ak'-lay-tos); an intercessor, consoler, advocate, comforter, helper.

Stepping into a life with the Holy Spirit is a comfort as it draws you into His light.

WHY ARE MANY LIVING A SPIRIT-LESS LIFE? - DISCONNECTED

SOME AREN'T AWARE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.

While Apollos was at Corinth, Paul took the road through the interior and arrived at Ephesus. There he found some disciples 2 and asked them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" They answered, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit."

SOME RESIST THE HOLY SPIRIT.

“You stiff-necked people, with uncircumcised hearts and ears! You are just like your fathers: You always resist the Holy Spirit.
