# Talking about The Ten Commandments

#### **The Third Commandment**

Remember the Sabbath Day by keeping it holy (Exodus 20:8).

#### What does this mean?

This means that we should fear and love God so that we do not despise His word and the preaching of it, but consider it to be holy and gladly hear and learn it.

#### **52** What are some ways to observe Sunday?

I may observe Sunday by meeting for public worship, hearing God's Word, and receiving the Lord's Supper; by showing kindness to others; and by using this day to rest and renew myself.

Hebrews 10:25 "...not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near."

Romans 10:17 "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ."

James 1:27 "Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world."

# **53** Are there other days which the church recognizes as being important?

Yes, the church considers as being important such days which mark events in the life of our Lord Jesus Christ in the time of His Incarnation. Some of these days are: Advent Sunday, Christmas Day, Epiphany, Palm Sunday, Good Friday, Easter, Ascension Day, and Pentecost.

# 54 How are these days arranged?

These days are arranged in a calendar known as the Church Year which begins on Advent Sunday, four Sundays before Christmas

Scriptures are noted in the English Standard Version

#### The Lord's Supper

#### Who may participate?

This sacrament is meant for believers in Jesus Christ (1 Corinthians 11:27-29). It is the way that God unites His church, sustains the church and grows faith, hope and love as the church participates in this shared grace together. Communion is God's way of delivering assurance of the forgiveness of sins to the flock.

#### What is received?

Christ gives to the communicants His body and blood - in, with, and under the bread and wine. He declares the forgiveness of sin to all believers, and strengthens their faith.

#### I feel I'm unworthy to receive

Being unworthy of Jesus<sup>†</sup> body and blood is the primary reason to receive the forgiveness of sins promised in communion. But it is possible to receive communion with an unworthy attitude. Therefore, self-examination is called for (1 Corinhians 11:28, 31).

#### I do well to ask myself:

I. Do I believe Jesus' promises?
"Without faith it is impossible to please God" (Hebrews 11:6).

#### 2. Do I recognize Jesus' presence?

"Whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. Anyone who eats and drinks without recognizing the body of the Lord eats and drinks judgment on himself" (I Cor. II:27, 29).

# 3. Am I reconciled with my fellow believers? If we do not value reconciliation with others, we put ourselves in a place where we are distancing ourselves from God's will for us. We are living in rebellion.

### 4. Do I recognize my sinfulness and that it will be the death of me?

### **5.** Is my hope in Jesus alone as the one who can give me eternal life?

We invite those who confess Jesus as their Savior from sin and death to receive the gift of forgiveness of sins offered and gifted in this sacrament.

#### A Note for Parents

Because communion requires time for self-examination, we do not encourage communion for children until they are old enough to be taught and old enough for self-examination. Through teaching they will appreciate its significance. Catechism Classes provide an opportunity to learn about the Lord's Supper. These classes are taught with the use of Luther's Small Catechism ...
