

# THANK YOU GOD

(Psalm 100)

1. **MAKE** some **NOISE!** (Psalm 35:27, 66:1, 81:1; 98:4, 118:15; Joshua 6:20; 2 Samuel 6:15; Zephaniah 3:14)
2. **SERVE** God with **JOY.** (Romans 12:1,11; Philippians 4:4; Colossians 3:23-24; Psalm 32:11; Exodus 23:25; Deuteronomy 28:47)
3. **COME** into His presence with **SINGING.** (Psalm 33:3, 95:1; Psalm 96, 147:1; Colossians 3:16; Acts 16:25; James 5:13; 1 Corinthians 14:15; Matthew 26:30)
4. **KNOW** Whom we **WORSHIP.** (Psalm 23, 95:7; Deuteronomy 4:28; 1 John 2:15; Hebrews 12:2; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 2 Peter 3:18; John 17:3; Philippians 3:10; Jeremiah 9:23-24; Exodus 34:6; Psalm 25:8; Mark 10:18; 1 John 4:16; Psalm 33:4; 1 Corinthians 1:9; 2 Thessalonians 3:3; Joshua 21:45)
5. **ENTER** - knowing there is a **PLACE** for me. (Matthew 27:50-51; Hebrews 4:14-16; Psalm 95:2, 139:7; Ephesians 2:18, 3:12; John 6:37)
6. **GIVE** God what He **DESERVES.** (1 Samuel 12:24; Revelation 4:11, 14:7; Psalm 48:1, 96:4; 2 Samuel 22:4; Psalm 126:3; Luke 1:49)
7. **BLESS** God with **ADORATION.** (Deuteronomy 6:5; Psalm 72:18, 103, 104:1, 134:1-2)

1. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
2. Is there a different between being thankful and giving thanks? Explain.
3. Many folks find it easy to shout and 'get excited' at ballgames, concerts, etc. Why might exuberance be shied away from in corporate Church gatherings?
4. Why is regular (corporate) worship alongside God's people so important?
5. According to Romans 12:1 (NKJV), offering ourselves as living sacrifices to God is our reasonable (rational) service, and Psalm 100:2 tells us to serve the Lord with gladness / delight. What often makes our service to God a drudgery instead of a delight? How might we be able to change this?
6. Sandwiched in the center of this psalm is the phrase "we are His" (verse 3). In what ways do you live like you belong to Him? In what ways do you live that would indicate you 'belong to yourself'? How does knowing we belong to God impact our ability to give thanks? What comfort should we find in knowing that we are "the sheep of His pasture"?
7. God's love for us is immeasurable - it is steadfast, it endures forever! Describe some ways you have experienced the love of God recently. How does this impact your outlook for moving forward in your life?
