(Exodus 2, Hebrews 11)

- 1. **HONOR** and **OBEY** God over and above and before any man. (Daniel 3:16-18; Job 13:15; Acts 4:19-20, 5:29; John 14:15; 1 Samuel 15:22)
- 2. Don't let yourself get paralyzed by the **FEAR** of what **MIGHT** happen. (Isaiah 41:10; 2 Timothy 1:7; Psalm 22:7, 23:4, 46:1-3; Deuteronomy 31:6; John 14:27; Matthew 6:27; 1 Peter 5:7)
- 3. Pray for eyes to spot a **GIFT** of God and a heart to **SAFEGUARD** that gift. (*James 1:7; Matthew 18:6,10; Ephesians 6:4; Psalm 127:3*)
- 4. Trust God even in moments that seem all **WRONG**. (Philippians 4:6-7; Romans 8:28; John 16:33; James 1:2-4; Isaiah 26:3; Psalm 50:15; Proverbs 3:6)
- 5. Stay close and get **INVOLVED** for the sake of someone else. (*Philippians 2:3-4; Hebrews 13:16; Galatians 6:2; Acts 8:29; Romans 12:10, 14:19; 1 Corinthians 12:25*)
- 6. Go **AGAINST** the flow of society (and sometimes even those closest to you.) (Romans 12:2; Matthew 10:37-38; 1 Peter 1:13-16; Philippians 3:20; James 4:4; 1 Corinthians 15:33; 1 John 2:15, 3:13)
- 7. There is a time when we must let **GO** of our children and let **GOD** have His way in them. (*Proverbs 22:6; Isaiah 55:11; Psalm 121:8; 2 Thessalonians 3:3; Psalm 5:11*)
- 8. Each and every time we pour into someone, it is an **INVESTMENT** for the future. (1 Thessalonians 5:11; Deuteronomy 3:28; Acts 11:23; Hebrews 3:13; Proverbs 27:17; 2 Corinthians 9:6; Matthew 28:19-20)

1.	Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
2.	In today's Scripture verses, the Hebrew midwives and Moses' mother (Jochebed) feared and honored God more than man and the demands of man. Who are some others in Scripture who did the same? How did God honor the midwives? In what ways have you seen God honor you for your obedience to Him?
3.	How are we tempted to honor / obey / yield to man before God? How might we be able to be a 'threat' to the kingdom of this world by putting God first?
4.	Exodus 2:2 says that Moses' mother saw that he was a "beautiful child" (NKJ) / "fine child" (ESV), and therefore hid him three months. Was this act of valor based solely on Moses' physical appearance as a baby? What more might this signify?
5.	The Hebrew women did not let the king's threats stop them from having children and leaving a heritage. Why does the 'fear of what might happen' often paralyze us? How are we to respond to this kind of fear?
6.	Trying to put yourself in Jochebed's shoes, what might have gone through her mind when she put her baby boy in a basket and let him float away? How can we trust God when the circumstances in our life seem so 'wrong'?
