


- 1. We must know God relationally not just **THEOLOGICALLY**, **INTELLECTUALLY** or **BIBLICALLY**.
- 2. God's name is truly embedded in everything both tangible and intangible. In everything that ever **WAS** and ever **WILL BE**. That is why His name is **HALLOWED**.
- 3. His **KINGDOM** is the place we want to be, and we want His will as the **TRUE GUIDE** of our lives.
- 4. We can begin to **UNDERSTAND** GOD's will in our lives when through **PRAYER** we make sure our choices **ALIGN** up with His **WILL** found in scripture.
- 5. Trust God to **PROVIDE** for your daily needs. If God has given you **EXTRA**, it is for your neighbor, not for you.
- 6. Forgiving others that have **HURT** or **SINNED** against you is not **DEPENDENT** on them **REPENTING** of that pain or sin.
- 7. Healing from a **HURT** or pain, begins by **FORGIVING** the one who caused the pain.
- 8. All of us have the **GUILT OF SIN** embedded in us from Adam's fall just like through God's grace all believers have **EMBEDDED** in them the righteousness of Christ.
- 9. You must change from the **INSIDE OUT** not the **OUTSIDE IN**.
