

DEPOSIT Worth using 2 Timothy 1:5-14



1. Parenting: We are called to FAN the flame of faith passed on to us, and PASS it on to the next generation.

2. Pace-Setting: We are called to SHARE in the suffering for the Gospel, and ENCOURAGE the next generation to do the same.

3. **Partnering**: We are called as ordinary people to <u>JOIN</u> an extraordinary partnership, and INVOLVE other ordinary people along with us.

1.	Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?

What does he mean by "we have a spirit not of fear, but of power and love and self control" (2 Timothy 1:7)? How can we strengthen our unique God given gifts for the benefit of others? How do we pass this flame onto others?
3.	Name some ways Paul suffered for the gospel? (Hint: See 1 Cor 11:22-28) How can we/do we share in this suffering today? Are you, not anyone else, willing to share in the suffering for the Gospel? How can you encourage others to share in this?
4.	Paul says in 1 Timothy 4:12 Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity. What other ways are you encouraged to look down on ourselves? How should we answer these lies? How can we help each other fight against these lies?
5.	What is the good deposit Paul mentions in this passage to Timothy? Do you see it as a precious deposit? How do you treat this deposit, be honest? How can we use the deposit entrusted to us?
