

1.	Trusting God's <u>timeline</u> will help you relieve your <u>fears</u> and give you <u>peace</u> about the <u>future</u> (Jeremiah 29:11, Philippians 1:6, Proverbs 19:21, Proverbs 3:5-6, 1 Peter 1:3-4)
2.	God is so kind and gracious that He wants us to see where we are in history and what is in store for us in the end . (Philippians 1:6, Romans 15:13, 2 Corinthians 4:17-18, Proverbs 16:4)
3.	When you <u>seek</u> to <u>understand</u> more about scripture, <u>ask</u> the <u>Holy Spirit</u> for He knows the mind of God. PRAY! (Colossians 1:9, Ephesians 4:18, Proverbs 3:5, Isaiah 11:2, Proverbs 2:3)
4.	Know how to read God's map so you will be prepared and be at peace . (John 16:33, Philippians 4:6-7, Psalms 4:8, Philippians 4:9, Isaiah 12:2, 1 Peter 5:7)
5.	If you have <u>accepted</u> Jesus Christ as your <u>savior</u> , you can be <u>confident</u> in the <u>future</u> He has in store for you. (Romans 10:9-11, John 14:6, John 3:5, John 3:16)
