

1.	The best <u>response</u> to <u>prophesy</u> is to <u>pray</u> . (Jeremiah 33:3, 2 Peter 1:20-21, Ezekiel 28:20)
2.	When you realize that you have <u>sinned</u> , <u>repent</u> and <u>acknowledge</u> your <u>sin</u> asking God for <u>forgiveness</u> . (1 John 1:9, Acts 2:38, 2 Chronicles 7:14, Matthew 1:15, Psalm 32:5, Jeremiah 3:13-14)
3.	God's <b>kindness</b> and <b>mercy</b> should lead us to <b>repentance</b> . (Romans 2:4, Colossians 3:13, 2 Corinthians 7:10)
4.	God wants us to <u>consider</u> His Word and <u>understand</u> it. (2 Timothy 3:16-17, Psalm 119:30, Proverbs 2:3-8, Revelation 1:3)
5.	<b>Prophecy</b> is written so that we may <b>know</b> God's timeline and not be <b>afraid</b> . (Matthew 24:6, Genesis 46:3, Psalm 56:4, Psalm 56:11, Isaiah 12:2, John 6:20, John 14:47)
