

Romans 9:1-13

1.	Do I have a BURDEN and deep SORROW over those who are not saved? (Jeremiah 9:1; Luke 19:41-42; Matthew 23:37; 2 Corinthians 2:4; Romans 10:1, 11:14; 2 Peter 3:9; Lamentations 3:48-49; Psalm 119:136)
2.	To what LENGTH am I willing to go to see the LOST come to faith in Jesus? (Exodus 32:30-32; Galatians 3:13; John 15:13; Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 1:8; Philemon 1:6; Romans 1:16; Isaiah 6:8; Luke 10:2)
3.	God's Word and promises HAVE not and WILL not FAIL . (Romans 3:1-4; Joshua 21:45; John 4:35-36; Isaiah 55:11; Joshua 1:5; 2 Corinthians 1:20; Numbers 23:19; 1 Kings 8:56; Hebrews 10:23; Ezekiel 12:28)
4.	God's <u>WAYS</u> are always <u>HIGHER</u> than ours. (Proverbs 3:5-6, 14:12; Isaiah 55:8-9; Romans 11:33; Psalm 86:11; Deuteronomy 29:29; Isaiah 14:24, 40:28; 1 Corinthians 13:12)
