Romans 9:30- 10:4

1.	Some people get what they do NOT PURSUE , while others MISS what they do PURSUE . (Acts 10; Isaiah 65:1; Hosea 2:23; Galatians 5:4; Philippians 3:9; Hebrews 4:1-2; Matthew 23:23; Luke 18:9)
2.	All that God has for us is received by FAITH and not WORKS . (Romans 1:17, 3:20, 33, 24, 28, 5:1, 6:23; Ephesians 2:8-9; Titus 3:5; Galatians 2:16, 3:10-12; Romans 11:6)
3.	ZEAL is a great thing, but it must be grounded in TRUTH . (Proverbs 19:2; 2 Samuel 21:2; Philippians 3:6; Galatians 1:13-14)
4.	When seeking FULFILLMENT , don't TRIP over JESUS . (Isaiah 8:14-15, 28:16; 1 Peter 2:4-8; Luke 2:34; Ephesians 2:20; Psalm 118:22; Luke 20:9-18; Matthew 7:24-27, 21:42-44, 23:37; 1 Corinthians 1:18-25; John 1:11-12, 5:39-40, 6:28-29)
