1.	So much can hinge on a SINGLE moment. (Genesis 1:3,12:4, 3:6; John 29:30; Luke 24:1-2)
2.	The enemy's presence is FORMIDABLE and his taunts are PIERCING . (1 Peter 5:8; Psalm 3:1-8, 27:3, 35:1, 55:3, 109:3; Ephesians 6:11)
3.	God wants us to be DILIGENT and DEVOTED . (Proverbs 6:6-8, 10:4, 12:24; Galatians 6:9; Ecclesiastes 9:10; Colossians 3:23; Romans 12:10; Luke 16:13)
4.	Seasons of attack and adversity can seem to last an ETERNITY . (Psalm 30:5; 2 Corinthians 4:8-10; James 1:2-4,12; Revelation 21:4; 1 Peter 5:10; Romans 5:3-5)
5.	God uses events and circumstances to get us to the right PLACE at the right TIME . (John 5:17; Philippians 2:13; Romans 8:28; Psalm 121:1-3; 1 Thessalonians 5:18)
