(2 Samuel 11)

1. **BE** where you're supposed to **BE** at the proper **TIME**. (Ecclesiastes 3:1; Matthew 6:13; Psalm 1:1-2, 141:4; 1 Corinthians 15:33; Proverbs 13:20, 22:24-25)
2. If we don't take our thoughts **CAPTIVE**, they will take us **CAPTIVE**. (Psalm 139:12-14; Genesis 3:1; Job 31:1; Mathew 5:27-28; James 1:14-15; 2 Corinthians 10:5; Romans 12:2; Philippians 4:8; Proverbs 4:23; Galatians 5:16-21)
3. **FLEE** when you need to **FLEE!** (Colossians 3:5-11; Genesis 39; 2 Timothy 2:22; Hebrews 4:13; 1 Corinthians 6:18-20; James 4:7; 1 Thessalonians 4:3-5)
4. God provides many ways of **ESCAPE** - take the **FIRST** one you see! (1 Corinthians 10:13; 1 John 1:9; James 1:2-4; Galatians 5:1; John 8:31-32)
5. When we **TAKE** what does not belong to us, we are **ROBBING** someone else. (Ephesians 4:30; Exodus 20:15; Proverbs 10:2; Romans 13:9; 1 Corinthians 13:5)
6. There is a **PRICE** to **PAY** for disobeying God. (Leviticus 20:10; James 1:15; Romans 6:23; 1 John 2:2; Ezekiel 18:4; Romans 5:12; Isaiah 59:2; Luke 6:46)
