

- 1. The King comes in authority and **POWER**. (Matthew 11:27, 28:18; Isaiah 55:8-11; Colossians 1:17; Psalm 147:5; Jeremiah 32:27; Ephesians 1:21; Philippians 2:9; Colossians 2:10)
- 2. The King comes to <u>FULFILL</u> promises made long ago. (Zechariah 9:9-10; Genesis 49:10-11; Isaiah 53; Galatians 4:4; John 7:6; Matthew 1:22, 2:23, 4:14, 8:17, 12:17, 21:4 26:18; Acts 13:29)
- 3. The King comes in **HUMILITY**. (*Philippians 2:5-8; 1 Kings 1:33; Judges 5:10, 10:4, 12:14; Luke 9:58; Galatians 3:13; 2 Corinthians 5:21, 8:9; Hebrews 4:15; Matthew 3:13-15; Luke 22:27; John 13:5; Mark 10:45*)
- 4. The King comes to receive **PRAISE**. (*Matthew 21:8; 2 Kings 9:13; Revelation 7:9-10; Psalm 118:25-26; Philippians 2:9-11; Revelation 4:11, 5:12*)
- 5. The King comes to **SAVE**. (1 John 2:2, 4:14; Luke 19:10; Matthew 1:21; John 3:16-17; 1 *Timothy* 1:15; *Revelation* 5:9)
- 6. The King comes to **SHAKE** things up! (Luke 19:39-40; John 12:19; Mark 11:11; Matthew 10:34; John 1:5; 2 Timothy 3:12; John 16:33)
- 7. The King comes to establish a **KINGDOM**. (*Mark 1:15, 11:10; Luke 17:20-21; John 18:36; Matthew 4:17, 6:10; Acts 28:31; Revelation 11:15; John 3:3*)

...and THE KING is coming again! (Zechariah 9:10, 14:1-9; Jude 14-15; Revelation 17:14; Revelation 19, 22:20)

- 5. Jesus tells us in **John 14:27**, "<u>Peace I leave with you</u>, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid." Then He says in **Matthew 10:34**, "Do not think that I came to bring peace on earth. <u>I did not come to bring peace</u> but a sword." Explain the differences here.
