


- 1. Be willing to **LEAVE** one 'good' thing for another potentially 'good' thing. (Exodus 2-3; 1 Kings 19:4-14; Matthew 4:1-11; 2 Timothy 2:15, 4:3; James 1:3; Colossians 2:7; Ephesians 3:14-21)
- Pray for God to give you eyes to see an <u>OPPORTUNITY</u> He places in front of you. (Ephesians 5:15-16; Galatians 6:10; 2 Peter 3:9; 2 Timothy 4:2; Colossians 4:5; 1 Peter 3:15)
- 3. Don't **HESITATE** to go **NEAR** someone when the Holy Spirit prompts you. (*John* 10:27-28; *Galatians* 6:2; *Hebrews* 6:10; 13:16; *Luke* 6:38; *Proverbs* 3:27; *Romans* 12:13; *Luke* 3:10-11; *Matthew* 25:35-40)
- 4. **OPEN** your mouth and tell the person in front of you about **JESUS**! (*Romans 10:14-15; Acts 1:8; Mark 16:15; Luke 2:38, 8:39; Matthew 4:19; Isaiah 55:11; Matthew 24:14*)
- 5. <u>**BE THERE</u>** to help someone take their <u>**NEXT**</u> <u>**STEP**</u>. (*Romans 10:9-10; Colossians 3:16;* Ephesians 5:19; Hebrews 10:24-25; 1 Thessalonians 5:11; Ecclesiastes 4:9-10; 1 Corinthians 14:26; Romans 14:19; Hebrews 3:13; Jeremiah 29:13)</u>
- 6. My <u>YIELDING</u> to God's <u>SENDING</u> me can lead to others' joy. (Proverbs 3:27; Matthew 10:8, 25:35-40; 2 Corinthians 9:6; Galatians 6:2; Hebrews 13:16)
