

5 elements of ADORATION

- 1. May I be in **AWE** of You, as the enormity of the gift of Jesus is **BEYOND** my ability to understand. (Luke 1:46-48, 2:13-20; Exodus 15:11; Deuteronomy 10:21; Psalm 2:11. 33:8, 46:10, 99:1; Isaiah 66:5; Jeremiah 5:22; Habakkuk 2:20; Revelation 15:4; Luke 5:26; Acts 2:43; Hebrews 12:28-29; Proverbs 9:10)
- 2. Lead me into wholehearted **DEVOTION** to You such that You are always my **PRIORITY**. (Matthew 2:1-2,9-11; Luke 2:25-33, 36-38; Matthew 6:33, 10:37-39; Exodus 20:3; Proverbs 3:5-6; Romans 12:1; 1 Corinthians 6:20; 1 Samuel 12:21-24; 1 Thessalonians 2:12; 2 Corinthians 5:15; Philippians 1:20; Deuteronomy 6:5)
- 3. Orient my heart to **OBEDIENCE** of Your every **LEADING** and command. (Mathew 1:18-25, 2:12; Luke 2 2:8-15; John 14:15,23; Deuteronomy 5:33; James 1:22; 1 Kings 2:3; Joshua 1:8; Psalm 128:1; 1 John 2:17; Galatians 1:10; 1 Samuel 15:22)
- 4. Help me embrace the **REVELATION** You give by the Holy Spirit and by Your **WORD**. (Luke 1:11,26,41,67; Matthew 1:20, 2:14,20,22; Matthew 2:2; Luke 2:25,26,27 Matthew 16:17; John 6:44, 14:26, 16:13; Romans 8:14; 2 Peter 1:20-21; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; Psalm 119:18; 1 Thessalonians 5:19; Hebrews 1:1-2)
- 5. May I live in a <u>CONSTANT</u> state of <u>EXPECTANCY</u>. (Luke 1:68-79, 2:34-35; Isaiah 7:14, 9:6, 11:1-3; Micah 5:2; Zechariah 9:9; Psalm 62:5; Romans 13:11; Matthew 24:42-44; 1 Corinthians 16:13; Psalm 85:8; Micah 7:7; Ephesians 3:20)

1.	Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
