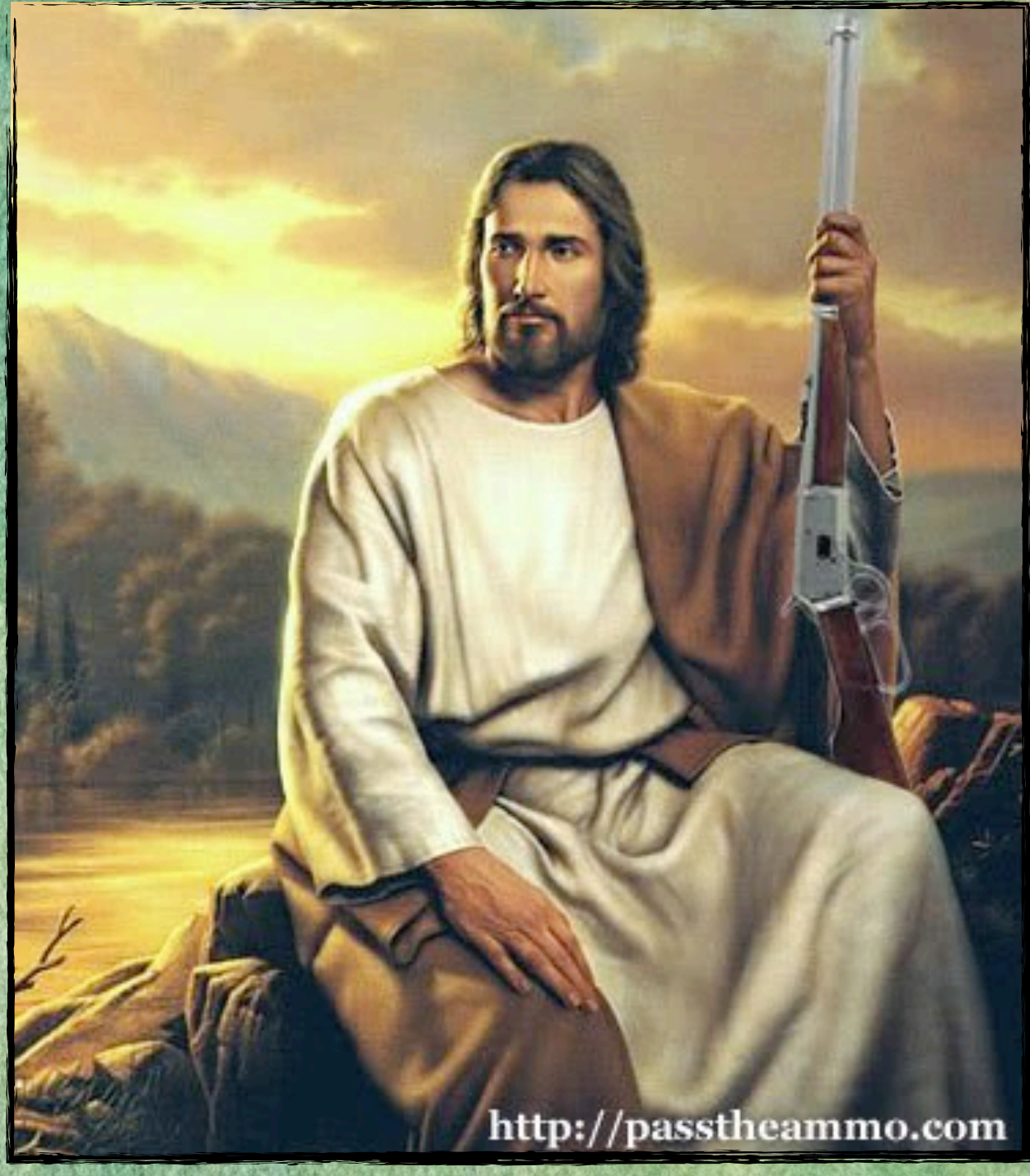

In Revelation 1 we saw a vision of Jesus like we had never seen before.

The Alpha and Omega

1:7 Behold, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him, and all tribes of the earth will wail on account of him. Even so. Amen.

The Lord used many different styles and tools in writing the Bible.

It would be a mistake for a believer to approach God's Word with a purely literalistic method of interpretation.

***Isaiah 60:16 You will drink the milk of nations and
be nursed at royal breasts.***

***Then you will know that I, the Lord, am your
Savior, your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob.***

Matthew 18:7 “Woe to the world for temptations to sin! For it is necessary that temptations come, but woe to the one by whom the temptation comes! 8 And if your hand or your foot causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life crippled or lame than with two hands or two feet to be thrown into the eternal fire. 9 And if your eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life with one eye than with two eyes to be thrown into the hell of fire.

The Bible is written in a way for us to partially comprehend what is incomprehensible.



Prove that love exists.

We are not the key to interpreting the Bible-

The Bible is.

1 Corinthians 13:8 Love never ends. As for prophecies, they will pass away; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will pass away. 9 For we know in part and we prophesy in part, 10 but when the perfect comes, the partial will pass away. 11 When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I gave up childish ways. 12 For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I have been fully known.

Let's look at Revelation 5

5:1 Then I saw in the right hand of him who was seated on the throne a scroll written within and on the back, sealed with seven seals. 2 And I saw a mighty angel proclaiming with a loud voice, “Who is worthy to open the scroll and break its seals?” 3 And no one in heaven or on earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll or to look into it, 4 and I began to weep loudly because no one was found worthy to open the scroll or to look into it.

What is the scroll?

Parchment written on front and back

Sealed with 7 seals

The number 7 is used 55 times.



5 And one of the elders said to me, “Weep no more; behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has conquered, so that he can open the scroll and its seven seals.”6 And between the throne and the four living creatures and among the elders I saw a Lamb standing, as though it had been slain, with seven horns and with seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth.

7 And he went and took the scroll from the right hand of him who was seated on the throne. 8 And when he had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each holding a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. 9 And they sang a new song, saying, “Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation,

10 and you have made them a kingdom and priests to our God, and they shall reign on the earth.”

11 Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands, 12 saying with a loud voice,

“Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!”

13 And I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea, and all that is in them, saying,

“To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and might forever and ever!”

14 And the four living creatures said, “Amen!” and the elders fell down and worshiped.

Beginning and the End - the Ancient of Days.**

**The Second picture of Jesus is the Messiah,
the victorious Lamb of God.**

Jesus fulfilled the Law on our behalf.

**Jesus was about to unlock the scroll of
final fulfillment**



The scroll represents the final fulfillment of God's will for the world.

Psalm 110:1 The Lord says to my Lord:

**“Sit at my right hand,
until I make your enemies your footstool.”**

**2 The Lord sends forth from Zion
your mighty scepter.**

Rule in the midst of your enemies!

**3 Your people will offer themselves freely
on the day of your power,
in holy garments;**

**from the womb of the morning,
the dew of your youth will be yours.**

**4 The Lord has sworn
and will not change his mind,
“You are a priest forever
after the order of Melchizedek.”**

**5 The Lord is at your right hand;
he will shatter kings on the day of his wrath.
6 He will execute judgment among the nations,
filling them with corpses;
he will shatter chiefs over the wide earth. 7 He
will drink from the brook by the way;
therefore he will lift up his head.**
