**John 1:1–2 (CSB)**

**1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.  
2 He was with God in the beginning.**

**John 1:14 (CSB)**

**14The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. We observed his glory, the glory as the one and only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.**

**Message made Flesh - Title for Christ.**

**God is a Communicator.**

## John 7:16–18 (CSB)

16 Jesus answered them, “My teaching isn’t mine but is from the one who sent me.

17 If anyone wants to do his will, he will know whether the teaching is from God or whether I am speaking on my own.

18 The one who speaks on his own seeks his own glory; but he who seeks the glory of the one who sent him is true, and there is no unrighteousness in him.

**Luke 6:12 (CSB)**

**12** During those days he went out to the mountain to pray and spent all night in prayer to God.

**Mark 1:35 (CSB)**

**35**Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he got up, went out, and made his way to a deserted place; and there he was praying.

17so that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

**Communication must be trustworthy.**

## Psalm 19:1–4 (CSB)

1 The heavens declare the glory of God, and the expanse proclaims the work of his hands.

2 Day after day they pour out speech; night after night they communicate knowledge.

3 There is no speech; there are no words; their voice is not heard.

4 Their message has gone out to the whole earth, and their words to the ends of the world. In the heavens he has pitched a tent for the sun.

those who love it will eat its fruit.**

**Know your spouse and speak edifying**
