



3 Now Joshua was standing before the angel, clothed with filthy garments.






We are responsible to use those spiritual tools that we are blessed with that bring us into step with the Lord that we may know His calling or purpose in our lives..




Romans 12:1–2 (ESV)

13and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be put out of joint but rather be healed.

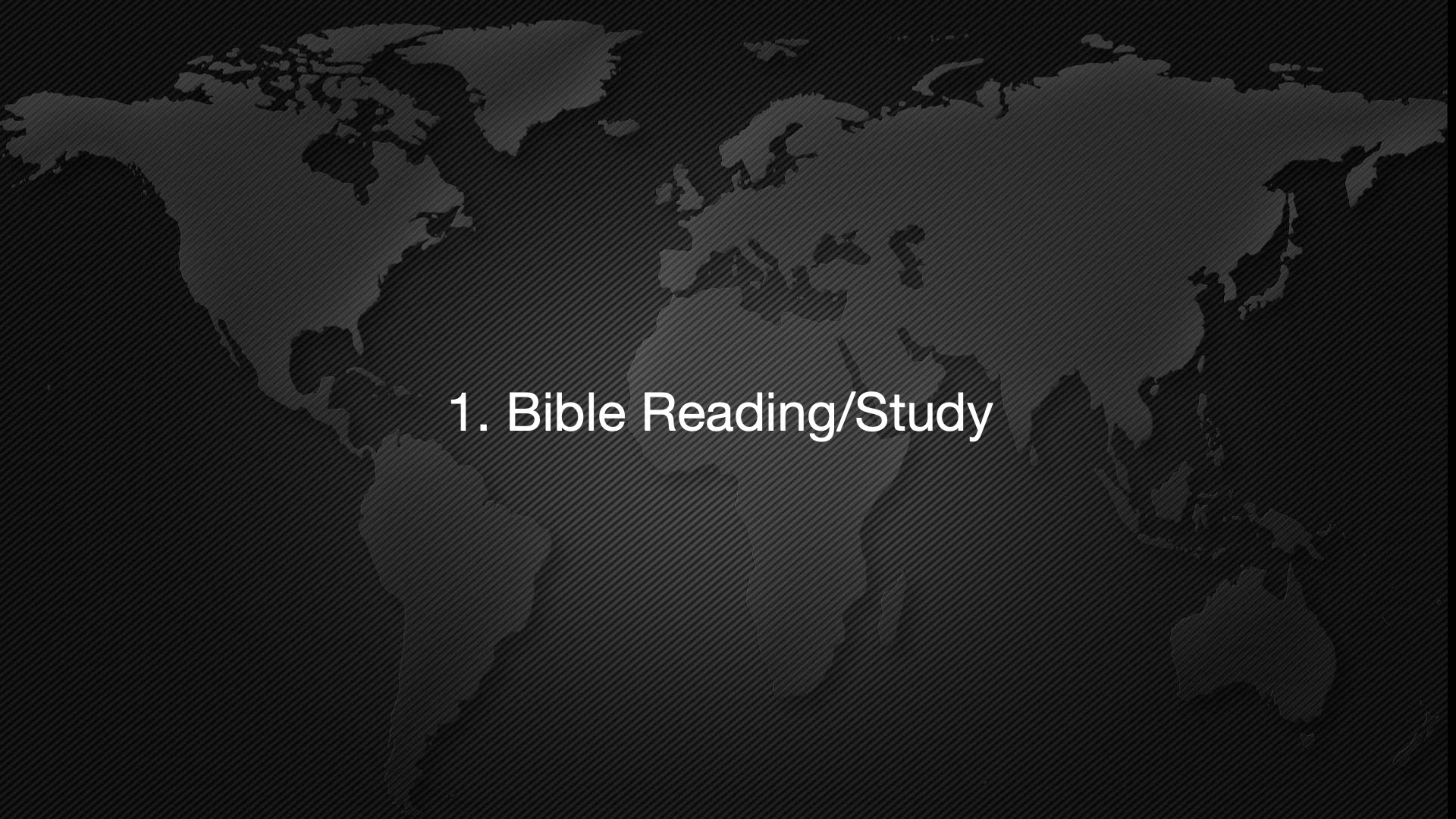
14Strive for peace with everyone, and for the holiness without which no one will see the Lord.


