



The True Gospel



Saved from God's wrath by grace through faith in
the redemptive work of Jesus the Son of God.

Making disciples is the command Jesus gave the Apostles before He ascended back to the right of God.

Matthew 28:19; Acts 1

So how do I make a true disciple of Jesus.

First: We have to know what the gospel is.

The Gospel is the good news concerning Christ
and the way of salvation.

Jude 1:3 Beloved, although I was very eager to write to you about our common salvation, I found it necessary to write appealing to you to contend for the faith that was once for all delivered to the saints.

Acts 2:42 And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

Galatians 1:6 I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel—
7 not that there is another one, but there are some who trouble you and want to distort the gospel of Christ. 8 But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you a gospel contrary to the one we preached to you, let him be accursed.

9 As we have said before, so now I say again: If anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to the one you received, let him be accursed.

10 For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ.

Hebrews 2:1 Therefore we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away from it. 2 For since the message declared by angels proved to be reliable, and every transgression or disobedience received a just retribution, 3 how shall we escape if we neglect such a great salvation? It was declared at first by the Lord, and it was attested to us by those who heard, 4 while God also bore witness by signs and wonders and various miracles and by gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to his will.

Second: Do not deviate from the Biblical model
we have been given.

2 Timothy 4:1 I charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearing and his kingdom: 2 preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching. 3 For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own passions,

4 and will turn away from listening to the truth and wander off into myths. 5 As for you, always be sober-minded, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

**Third: Everywhere you go let the light of the Lord
shine through you.**

In self defense I teach people to think of scenarios and have a plan because know your surroundings and act accordingly.

The same is true spiritually; as you go through your day look and listen for the Holy Spirit.

If your thing is knocking on doors, great.

Never go alone, it creeps people out.

Don't stand in the doorway, it also creeps people out.

I am a Christian/born again believer in Jesus and a member of NLF and I just came by to introduce myself.

I have some things for you that tells the story of the Good News of Jesus and why being saved is so important.

Do you know Jesus as Lord and Saviour?

This will go one of two ways.

I am a Christian or maybe they will tell you they
are not.

Realize that you are experiencing a divine
appointment.

Let the Lord manage the meeting.

The person in front of you belongs to the Lord and the Holy Spirit has sent them to you in order to make His appeal to them through you.

Listen and assess what they think they know.

Listen to the person's history and listen for the response of the Holy Spirit.

2Corinthians 5:20 Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. 21 For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God

If they are Christian: You might ask how long have you been a Christian? Or, where do you go to church?

The biggest mistake we can make is trying to get them into heaven without introducing them to Jesus.

Through these questions you can determine if they are saved and are they being disciplined.

They also may tell you they are not Christians.

Have you heard about the Good News of Jesus?

Here is where you really watch the individual's body language and listen to the Holy Spirit.

One thing to remember is, whether or not that person follows Jesus is not your responsibility.

1Corinthians 3:1 But I, brothers, could not address you as spiritual people, but as people of the flesh, as infants in Christ. ²I fed you with milk, not solid food, for you were not ready for it. And even now you are not yet ready, ³for you are still of the flesh. For while there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not of the flesh and behaving only in a human way?

⁴For when one says, "I follow Paul," and another, "I follow Apollos," are you not being merely human?

⁵What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, as the Lord assigned to each.

⁶I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. ⁷So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth. ⁸He who plants and he who waters are one, and each will receive his wages according to his labor. ⁹For we are God's fellow workers. You are God's field, God's building.

¹⁰According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building upon it. Let each one take care how he builds upon it. ¹¹For no one can lay a foundation other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

¹²Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw—
¹³each one's work will become manifest, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done. ¹⁴If the work that anyone has built on the foundation survives, he will receive a reward. ¹⁵If anyone's work is burned up, he will suffer loss, though he himself will be saved, but only as through fire.

¹⁶Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you? ¹⁷If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy him. For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple.

¹⁸Let no one deceive himself. If anyone among you thinks that he is wise in this age, let him become a fool that he may become wise. ¹⁹For the wisdom of this world is folly with God. For it is written, "He catches the wise in their craftiness," ²⁰and again, "The Lord knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are futile."

²¹So let no one boast in men. For all things are yours, ²²whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas or the world or life or death or the present or the future —all are yours, ²³and you are Christ's, and Christ is God's.



Oh you are not a Christian, just pray and ask
Jesus to save you.

We must build on the foundation prepared for us
by Jesus and the Apostles.

Revelation 21: 14 And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the twelve names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.
