Welcome to Fusion! Each week we will be sending students the weekly Fusion teaching and a few action steps to help them engage with the principles during the week. It's easy... have your students watch the video, then follow the plan to invest time in their bibles, and in the people around them. Teaching notes, including discussion questions, and a copy of the Fusion Workbook is attached for additional resources.

Once a week, leaders will host “virtual small groups” through tools like FaceTime, Google Hangouts, or Zoom. Leaders will work closely with parents to plan and accomplish these groups. Use this time to catch up with students, ask how they are engaging the teaching and their bibles, and challenge them in the weeks to come.

As uncertainty looms, we want to encourage you to view this time as an opportunity to strengthen and deepen your faith in Jesus. We also want to encourage our students to not waste these moments, but to invest in their efforts to follow Christ. ### **Step 1**

### **Step 2**

Throughout the week, follow the plan for reading your bible and engaging in relationships around you every day.

Day 1: Read Luke 5:17-26. Spend quality time with your family, growing in your relationship by doing one fun activity with them. (Cooking, running, board game, etc)

Day 2: Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-27. Have a conversation with a parent about what it means to be relationally connected. Ask them how they pursue biblical community and if they have advice on how you could do this better.



Day 3: Read Philippians 2:1-11. Connect with a relative (grandparent, aunt, uncle, etc) by giving them a call or writing them a letter just to check in on them and see how they are doing.

Day 4: Read 1 John 3:11-24. Carve out time to pray for the following ideas: Pray that God would give you relationships to help you grow in your faith and to help remind you of God's presence in your life. Pray that the relationships that God has already given you would grow and mature so that they would become more effective tools in helping you follow Jesus.

Day 5: Read 1 John 4:7-21. Connect with your small group.
