Hebrews 3:1-4

As believers we have direct access to God's messenger and High Priest, Jesus. However we often settle for "good" when we have access to "great." We get focused on and place our hope in the things of this world rather than the One who created all of these things. We focus on the house, when our praise and worship should be directed at the builder of the house. We should strive daily to enjoy the things of this world for the ultimate glory of the Creator.

5. (For parents)- In what ways have you placed your identity in the performance or behavior of your children rather than in Christ? How can you change your approach for the benefit of both you and your children?
