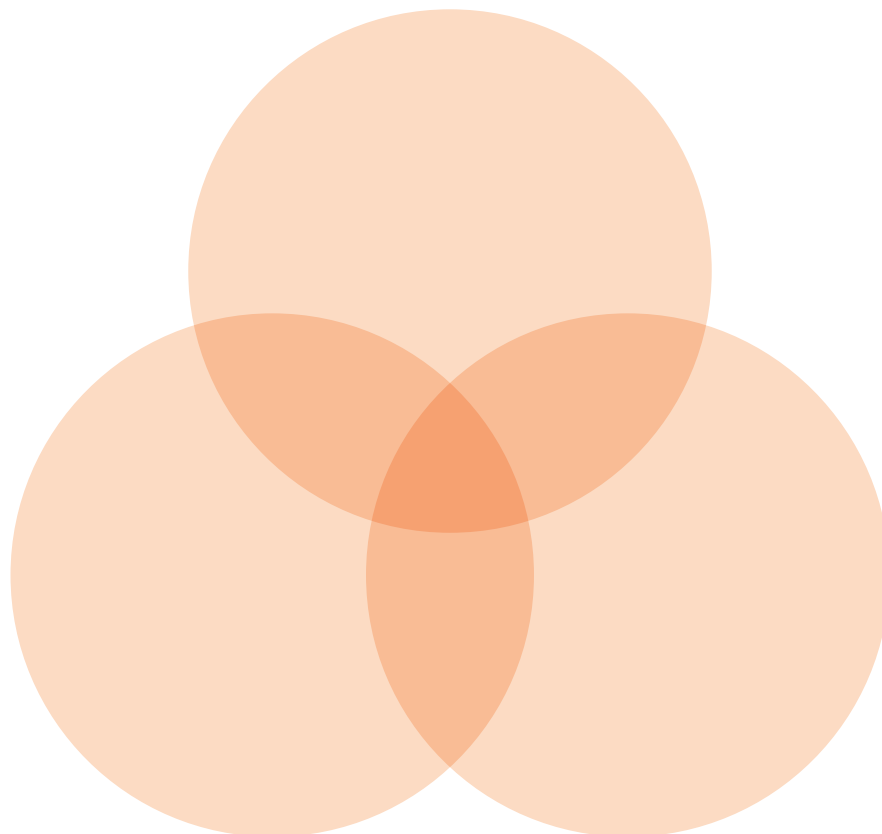


ONE MAN'S HEART
