Week 4- Girls
Inviting Redeemed

Main Idea: God redeemed us, which includes our capacities to invite, nurture, and partner.

Principles:

God invites by welcoming everyone into a relationship with Him. He shows us that inviting in a redeemed way is broad and inclusive. (Matthew 11, Psalm 27:1, 1 Peter 5:7, Psalm 55:22)

Nurturing in a redeemed way requires an outward focus, thinking of others the way God thinks of us. It is caring for others in a way that will help them be who God designed them to be.

The trinity is the essence of partnering and helps us understand how we can come alongside and strengthen others in a sacrificial way.

Questions:

- What does it mean to be redeemed and how can someone or something be redeemed?
- How is God calling you to reflect His inviting nature in a redeemed way?
- How has someone nurtured you in a sacrificial way?
- What does it look like for someone to make a sacrifice, or give up something, in order to nurture or partner with someone else? Have you done this or seen someone else do it?
- How does the Trinity show a beautiful and perfect image of partnering?
- Overall, would your core capacities to invite, nurture, and partner typically be expressed in a redeemed or corrupted way?
- Have you been redeemed?
- How is God calling you to move based on what you have heard and discussed?
