GOD is ALL-POWERFUL

"He is more powerful than I can imagine, and my lack of power pushes me to Him."

Text: Isaiah 44:24

"This is what the Lord says your Redeemer and Creator: I am the Lord, who made all things. I alone stretched out the heavens. Who was with me when I made the earth?"

He is more powerful than I could ever imagine, and my lack of power makes me dependent on Him - the source of all power.

Am I depending on God?

GOD is I ALL-KNOWING

"He has all knowledge of everything, and my lack of knowledge pushes me toward Him."

Text: Psalm 139:1-6

"O Lord, you have examined my heart and know everything about me. You know when I sit down or stand up. You know my thoughts even when I'm far away. You see me when I travel and when I rest at home. You know everything I do. You know what I am going to say even before I say it, Lord. You go before me and follow me. You place your hand of blessing on my head. Text: Isaiah 30:18 - NASB

"Therefore, the LORD longs to be gracious to you, and therefore He waits on high to have compassion on you For the LORD is a God of justice; How blessed are all those who long for Him."

God gives favor despite my inability to earn it. This gives me cause to celebrate and extend grace to others whether they deserve it or not.

Am I thankful for God's grace and do I give it to others?
