Nehemiah 1

- Imagine walking through a city that is in shambles...the walls are crumbling, stones scattered, and gates burned.
- The Story of Nehemiah, in the OT was exactly that.
 - Crumbling Walls, Gates burned with Fire A once magnificent structure, Solomon's Temple, now lie in ruins
 - Jerusalem's broken walls were more than a physical problem—they were a symbol of vulnerability, shame, and lost identity. The people felt exposed, defeated, and hopeless.
- The Story of Nehemiah opens as word gets to Nehemiah about the situation in Jerusalem.
- God gave Nehemiah a vision to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem for the glory and renown of His name!

It's not so different from our lives today – We see the brokenness everywhere we look

• Broken Lives, families in shambles – heartache, heartbreak, pain and agony abound

But just as Nehemiah saw the ruins and was moved to rebuild, God calls us not to ignore the brokenness, but to face it with hope.

• Just as Nehemiah rallied people, praying and trusted God's provision, In the same way, God invites us to carry the hope giving gospel to all those around us.

We are drawing our sermon series – Unstoppable Force to a close – We begin Matthew.

- We have laid out framework for how God has called us to be a people of hope for the world.
- There are several things I want you so see from this story Particularly as it relates to Vision.
- With the help of the Holy Spirit, we will draw application from this passage of Scripture and close with a call to action!

The story of Nehemiah happens as the Nation of Israel was...

- Under the control of King Artaxerxes of Persia
- Jerusalem had been besieged; the Temple had been destroyed; the walls were broken down by the King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon Babylonians conquered by Persians.
- Nehemiah is the Cup Bearer of this Persian King gets word about how things are at home...

Nehemiah 1:3-4 - And they said to me, "The survivors who are left from the captivity in the province *are* there in *great distress and reproach*. The wall of Jerusalem *is* also broken down, and its gates are burned with fire."

Nehemiah 1:4 - ⁴ So it was, when I heard these words, that I sat down and wept, and mourned *for many* days; I was fasting and praying before the God of heaven.

Fast - forward a bit...

Nehemiah 6:15-16 - So the wall was finished on the twenty-fifth *day* of Elul, in fifty-two days. ¹⁶ And it happened, when all our enemies heard *of it*, and all the nations around us saw *these things*, that

they were very disheartened in their own eyes; for they perceived that this work was done by our God.

Nehemiah Confronted the Challenge - Confronted the Brutal Facts – He Prayed!

• Notice He starts with Prayer...verse 5

Nehamiah 1:5 - And I said: "I pray, Lord God of heaven, O great and awesome God, *You* who keep *Your* covenant and mercy with those who love You and observe Your commandments, ⁶ please let Your ear be attentive and Your eyes open, that You may hear the prayer of Your servant which I pray before You now, day and night, for the children of Israel Your servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel which we have sinned against You. Both my father's house and I have sinned.

Nehemiah 1:7 - ⁷ We have acted very corruptly against You, and have not kept the commandments, the statutes, nor the ordinances which You commanded Your servant Moses. ⁸ Remember, I pray, the word that You commanded Your servant Moses, saying, 'If you are unfaithful, I will scatter you among the nations; ⁹ but if you return to Me, and keep My commandments and do them, though some of you were cast out to the farthest part of the heavens, yet I will gather them from there, and bring them to the place which I have chosen as a dwelling for My name.' ¹⁰ Now these are Your servants and Your people, whom You have redeemed by Your great power, and by Your strong hand. ¹¹ O Lord, I pray, please let Your ear be attentive to the prayer of Your servant, and to the prayer of Your servants who desire to fear Your name; and let Your servant prosper this day, I pray, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man."

For I was the king's cupbearer.

It was a prayer of Praise, Repentance, Asking God to Work, Yielding

Vision always begins with Prayer!

- Two Weeks ago I challenged us to Pray for 21 Days If you have not joined in, let me encourage you to begin today.
- A Mighty move of God always, always begins with Prayer!
- The Early Church that filled Jerusalem with the doctrine of Christ were devoted to prayer Acts 2:42
- Beginning in Jan., we will set aside the 25th of Every Month to Fast and Pray for the Lord to do a great work in us and through us for the glory of Jesus' name.

Persevere with your Plan

If you go back to Nehemiah 2, you see the Plan Starts with Prayer, God-Given Strategy

Nehemiah 1:11 - O Lord, I pray, please let Your ear be attentive to the prayer of Your servant, and to the prayer of Your servants **who desire to fear Your name**; and let Your servant prosper this day, I pray, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man."

Lord if you don't work, this is not going to be done - We desire to glorify your name.

Nehemiah 2 – 4 Months later, Nehemiah is going about his business serving the King

- Nehemiah is going about his duties as cupbearer King notices something is off
- King Artty says, Nehemiah, why are you sad
- Nehemiah says, King, the situation in my homeland is not good I want to go back and rebuild it (Nehemiah 2:4)
- King Art, says What do you need? Nehemiah responds

Nehemiah 2:7-8 - Furthermore I said to the king, "If it pleases the king, let letters be given to me for the governors of the region beyond the River, that they must permit me to pass through till I come to Judah, ⁸ and a letter to Asaph the keeper of the king's forest, that he must give me timber to make beams for the gates of the citadel which pertains to the temple, for the city wall, and for the house that I will occupy." And the king granted them to me according to the good hand of my God upon me.

One Author said, when faced with adversity, Nehemiah did not run to the king, he took 4 months to pray and plan.

- Through the Gentile King Artazerxes, He provides everything needed to accomplish the task.
- Nehemiah Formulated A Plan He began with Prayer, then a Plan
- Spiritual Principle When God calls you to do something, He always supplies.
- God has given Thorsby First Baptist all the resources we need to accomplish the task that he
 has given us.
- The question is, are we living open handed?

We have been given a Mission to Accomplish

- To equip people to relentlessly pursue God's Design.
- We do this by helping people live out our Values
 - o We Value God's Word So we help people Abide in Christ,
 - We Value People We help people Connect in Biblical / Meaningful Relationships,
 - We Value the Gospel We train you to share their time, talent and treasure to build up the body to reach others with the Gospel of Christ.
- How do I know if I am living this out?
 - How's Your *God* Time? There is a significant spiritual, emotionally and psychological benefit to those spending 4 or more days in God's Word.

- How's Your *Gather* Time? Is Church a priority Again, research show the value of weekly worship
- How's Your *Group* Time? Stop me if you have heard this before, but research shows the benefit of being connected in a group for mutual encouragement and edification.
- o How's Your *Give* Time? Research shows, generous people are cheerful people
- o How's Your **Go** Time? Are you sharing what God is doing in your life with others.
- These are handles, if you will to know if you are living out the Values
- This is our Plan and we are sticking to it

Move when you have Momentum

Nehemiah 6:1-9 - Now it happened when Sanballat, Tobiah, Geshem the Arab, and the rest of our enemies heard that I had rebuilt the wall, and *that* there were no breaks left in it (though at that time I had not hung the doors in the gates), ² that Sanballat and Geshem sent to me, saying, "Come, let us meet together among the villages in the plain of Ono." But they thought to do me harm.

³ So I sent messengers to them, saying, "I am doing a great work, so that I cannot come down. Why should the work cease while I leave it and go down to you?"

The scripture we read today you can see how the momentum didn't mean ...

- that there were no haters; the momentum didn't mean that there were no obstacles
- The momentum didn't mean that there were no critics in fact it's the opposite people were always trying to derail the momentum that Nehemiah had,
- but Nehemiah never stopped!
- Nehemiah refused to press pause! Nehemiah just kept going he persevered with his plan and he finished his work.
- At First Baptist, by God's Graces, we have good momentum.
- Now is not the time to rest on our laurels Sit Back, Relax, Take it Easy, Put things on Cruize Control and be content with the status quo.
- Status Quo never changed the World
- This is the time to persevere with our plan Obstacles? Sure! Naysayers and haters, absolutely.
- But when you have God's momentum you don't let anything stop you!

We have seen God do amazing things at First Baptist.

- To God Be the Glory, Great Things He has done!
- Over the past 14 years, we have seen God do amazing things.
 - o We have grown numerically, financially, but most of all spiritually
- People have been saved and Baptized May 2021 we set aside the first Sunday of every month for Baptism Sunday – We had no one scheduled when we planned that

⁴ But they sent me this message four times, and I answered them in the same manner.

- That first Sunday, We had 2 By God's Grace we have seen 82 baptized
- As we mentioned a few moments ago, we have raised over \$1 Million above and beyond regular general fund giving – While fully funding all ministries as well as maintaining Cooperative Program 10% 1.5% to Chilton Baptist Association.
- o Believers have been equipped and encouraged to relentlessly pursue God's Design.
- Through Group Life, men and women, boys and girls have been taught the Word of God.
- o I praise the Lord for what He has done
- But there is more work to be done
 - We look at our Country, our State, our Community and we see unrest. We see brokenness. We see the breakdown of the family. We see the generational sin continue to ravage our communities.
 - We have the Hope We must seize the day Run into the darkness with the Hope of the Gospel
 - We are on a vision is to bring hope and renewal to every person and every place
 - By Spiritually forming believers By raising up leaders in our homes, communities and churches – by saturating Thorsby and Beyond with the Gospel of Jesus

I love what Paul said in I Corinthians 3:

I Corinthians 3:6-8 - I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase. ⁷ So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase. ⁸ Now he who plants and he who waters are one, and each one will receive his own reward according to his own labor.

Focus on the Future

Nehemiah 6:15 - ¹⁵ So the wall was finished on the twenty-fifth *day* of Elul, in fifty-two days. ¹⁶ And it happened, when all our enemies heard *of it,* and all the nations around us saw *these things,* that they were very disheartened in their own eyes; *for they perceived that this work was done by our God.*

- Nehemiah build that wall and made those sacrifices and worked hard because he want to build something for the next generation.
- the late Michael Catt, long-time pastor of Sherwood Baptist in Albany, Ga., say many times, "Whoever wants the next generation the most will get them."
- Travel and school sports are reaching them. Social media is certainly reaching them. All types of entertainment are reaching them. Iconic celebrities and stars are reaching them.
 The list goes on.
- Whoever will prioritize and intentionally pursue reaching them will get them. The world is doing it. Are we?
