

The Responsibilities of a Peacemaker

1.To share with others how they can have peace with God – 2 Cor. 5:19-20

2.To pursue peace in my relationships with others – Heb. 12:14a, I Thess. 5:13b

3. To seek to bring peace between others – *Philippians* 4:2-3



Four Aspects in the Formation of Becoming a Peacemaker

Glorify God – I Cor. 10:31 Get the log out – Mt. 7:1-5 Gently Restore – Gal. 6:1 Go and Be Reconciled – Mt 5:23-24; Mt. 18
