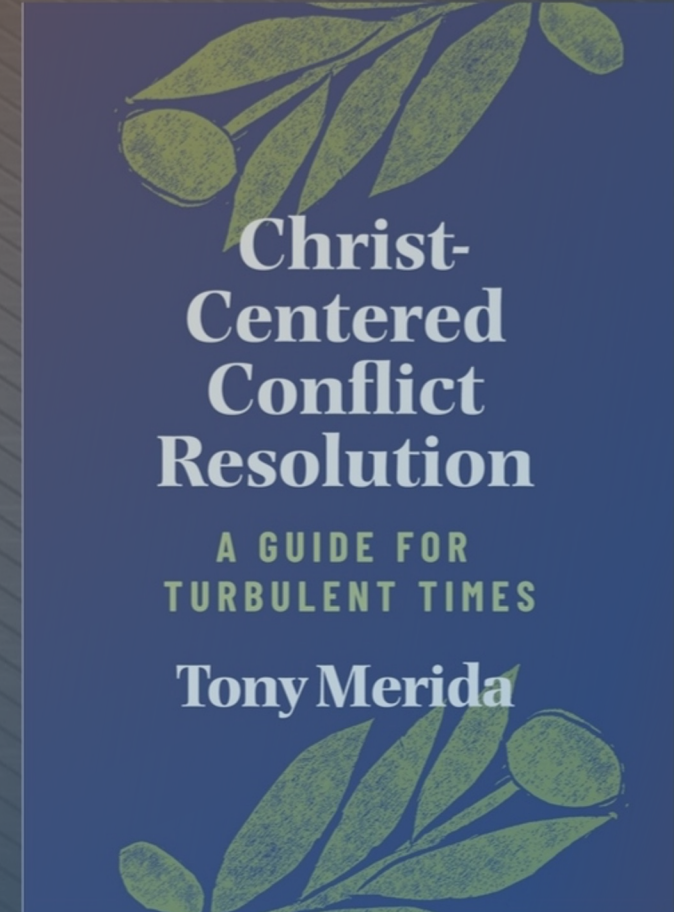
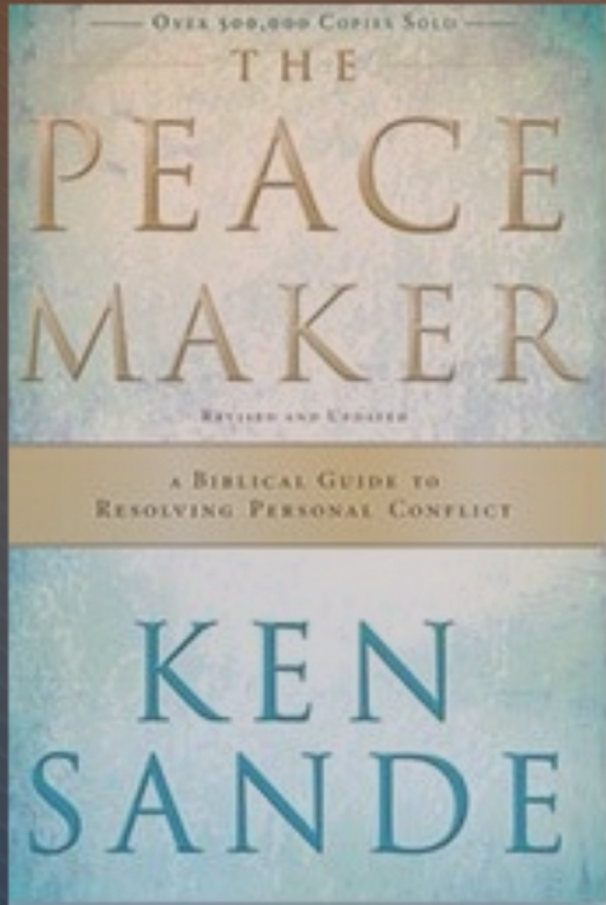

Foundation for Being a Peacemaker Is the Gospel of Jesus Christ

Rom. 5:1; 5:6-11; Eph. 2:13-15; 2 Cor. 5:17-21



The Responsibilities of a Peacemaker

1. To share with others how they can have peace with God
– ***2 Cor. 5:19-20***
2. To pursue peace in my relationships with others
– ***Heb. 12:14a, 1 Thess. 5:13b***
3. To seek to bring peace between others – ***Philippians 4:2-3***



Four Aspects in the Formation of Becoming a Peacemaker

Glorify God – I Cor. 10:31

Get the log out – Mt. 7:1-5

Gently Restore – Gal. 6:1

Go and Be Reconciled – Mt 5:23-24; Mt. 18
