The Theology of the Holy Spirit

Adapted from Forgotten God (Francis Chan) & Baptist Faith & Message

1. He is a Person – not a force or thing (He)
2. He is God (He is Omnipotent, Omnipresent, Omniscient)
3. He is Eternal and Holy
4. He has a mind and emotions – Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God
5. He intercedes to the Father for the Saints – Rom. 8
6. He regenerates the lost, He Seals/indwells Believers, Bestows gifts

accomplish a threefold Purpose***

To Convict Sinners – John 16:8-11

To Counsel Saints – John 16:12-13

To Champion the Savior – John 16:14-15

Theology of this Series

Abide (John 15:5) “It is impossible to follow Jesus without abiding in Him.”

Connect (Rom. 12:5) “God has designed His Church as a body. In order to follow Jesus, I must be engaged in His family.”

Share (2 Tim. 2:2; Mt. 5:13-15) “A true follower of Christ cannot hoard their faith, they are compelled to share and multiply it in others.”

These are all based in relationship. Relationship with God, relationship with other believers, and relationship with the world.



Application of this Series

Every quality relationship requires **Time**.

There is no growing relationship apart from time spent together. Therefore:

God Time: an intentional pursuit of God daily – Ps. 84:10-11; Mark 1:35

Gather Time: a love for God's family in gathered worship – Col. 3:16; Heb. 10:25

Group Time: a commitment to consistent growth and accountability with a community of believers – Acts 2:42-47; Heb. 10:24

Give Time: a resolve to steward the gifts God has entrusted to me – I Peter 4:7-11

Go Time: Time spent regularly seeing the gospel spread locally and globally – Acts 1:8
