Title: Proof Positive **Text:** 1 John 5:1-12

Target: The testimony of what God has brought you THROUGH can be mightily used to bring

someone TO the ultimate truth of Jesus.

- I. Testimony of Salvation: "Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has been born of God, and everyone who loves the Father loves whoever has been born of him." (Vs. 1)
 - A. Mindfulness of the Need: "everyone who believes"
 - B. Meaning of the Name: "that Jesus is the Christ"
 - C. Made completely New: "born of God"
- **II. Testimony of** <u>Transformation</u>: "By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments." (Vs.2)
 - **A. Delight in His Word:** "For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome." (Vs. 3)
 - **B.** Deliverance from the World: "For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world." (Vs.4a)
 - **1. Overcome Sin:** "And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith." (Vs. 4b)
 - 2. Overcome Death: "Who is it that overcomes the world except the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?" (Vs. 5)
- III. Testimony of <u>Verification</u>: "This is he who came by water and blood—Jesus Christ; not by the water only but by the water and the blood. And the Spirit is the one who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth." (Vs. 6)
 - A. Agreement of the Testimony: "for there are three that testify: the Spirit and the water and the blood; and these three agree." (Vs. 7-8) Key Passage: Matthew 3:13-17
 - 1. The Witness of the Water: The Baptism of Jesus
 - 2. The Witness of the Blood: The Cross of Jesus
 - 3. The Witness of the Spirit: The Resurrection of Jesus
 - B. Acceptance of the Testimony: "Whoever believes in the Son of God has the testimony in himself. Whoever does not believe God has made him a liar, because he has not believed in the testimony that God has borne concerning his Son." (Vs. 10)
- **IV. Testimony of Confirmation**: "And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. (Vs.11)
 - A. Eternal Life is a Gift: "gave us eternal life"
 - **B. Eternal Life is a Guarantee:** "Whoever has the Son has life, whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life." (Vs. 12)

Takeaway: "And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent." (John 17:3)
