Title: Look in the Mirror Part 2

Text: Revelation 3

Target: To no longer just go through the motions for the sake of motions, but for a movement of

God.

- **I.** Sardis: Reality conflicts with Reputation: "I know your works. You have the reputation of being alive, but you are dead." (Vs. 1)
 - A. Call to Wake-Up:
 - **1.** Give Attention to the Immediate: "Wake up, and strengthen what remains and is about to die," (Vs.2a)
 - **2.** Get Awareness to the Apparent: "for I have not found your works complete in the sight of my God." (Vs. 2b)
 - B. Call to Look-In: "Remember, then, what you received and heard. Keep it, and repent. If you will not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come against you." (Vs.3)
 - C. Call to Be-Around: "Yet you have still a few names in Sardis, people who have not soiled their garments, and they will walk with me in white, for they are worthy." (Vs. 4)
 - **D.** Call to Stand-Out: "The one who conquers will be..." (Vs. 5)
 - 1. Considered Righteous: "clothed thus in White Garments" (Vs. 5)
 - Counted as Righteous: "Never blot his name out of the book of Life."
 (Vs. 5)
 - Conveyed as Righteous: "Confess his name before my Father and before his Angels." (Vs. 5)
- II. Philadelphia: Open door of Opportunity: "The words of the holy one, the true one, who has the key of David, who opens, and no one will shut, who shuts and no one opens." (Vs. 7)
 - A. Small, but Strong: "I know that you have but little power, and yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name." (Vs. 8)
 - **B.** Stable and Secure: "behold, I will make them come and bow down before your feet, and they will learn that I have loved you." (Vs. 9)
 - C. Steadfast in the Struggle: "Because you have kept my word about patient endurance, I will keep you from the hour of trial that is coming on the whole world, to try those who dwell on the earth." (Vs. 10)
 - **D.** Significantly Sure: "I am coming soon. Hold fast what you have, so that no one may seize your crown. The one who conquers I will make ..." (Vs. 11-12)
 - 1. God's Name is on our Heart: "I will write on him the name of my God." (Vs. 12b)
 - **2.** Heaven is our Home: "...and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem." (Vs. 12c)
- III. Laodicea: <u>Lukewarm is not an Option:</u> "The words of the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of God's creation." (Vs.14)

- A. The Description of Apathy: "I know your works: you are neither cold nor hot. Would that you were either cold or hot!" (Vs. 15)
- B. The Disgust of Apathy: "So, because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth." (Vs. 16)
- C. The Drift towards Apathy: "For you say, I am rich, I have prospered, and I need nothing, not realizing that you are wretched, pitiable, poor, blind, and naked." (Vs. 17) *Gold, white garments, eye salve (Vs. 18)
- **D.** The Discipline because of Apathy: "Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, so be zealous and repent." (Vs. 19)
- E. The Disruption of Apathy: "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me." (Vs. 20)

Take Away: When you pride yourself in the past, you presume upon the future, you pass over the present! Seize this moment!
