00:00:06.799 - 00:00:11.099

As we kind of continue in this direction that we've been the last few weeks.

00:00:11.099 - 00:00:13.000

The mission starts here.

00:00:13.000 - 00:00:19.699

And I know we've kind of been in this kind of idea leading into Vacation Bible School,

00:00:19.699 - 00:00:33.299

because it is a time that we are really kind of focused on reaching out and making sure everybody knows that we're here and that we want people to e and be with us.

00:00:33.299 - 00:00:35.200

And so we started out the first week.

00:00:35.200 - 00:00:38.200

The first week we started out with the idea of what the mission is.

00:00:38.200 - 00:00:43.799

The mission is for us to go and make disciples.

00:00:43.799 - 00:00:46.300

Go and make other followers of Jesus.

00:00:46.300 - 00:00:50.100

Convince them that this is the best life for you to live.

00:00:50.100 - 00:00:52.609

I love the fact that Jesus didn't say,

00:00:52.609 - 00:00:56.600

"I'm going to make you follow me". He gives us a choice.

00:00:56.600 - 00:00:57.479

And in our lives,

00:00:57.479 - 00:00:59.440

when we have choices to do something,

00:00:59.440 - 00:01:01.899

we make the choice to follow Jesus.

00:01:01.899 - 00:01:03.049

That makes that decision,

00:01:03.049 - 00:01:03.450 I think,

00:01:03.450 - 00:01:04.200

more powerful,

00:01:04.200 - 00:01:06.200

it makes it more sincere.

00:01:06.200 - 00:01:08.900

Because it's not something that we have to do,

00:01:08.900 - 00:01:10.500

it's something that we choose to do.

00:01:10.500 - 00:01:18.299

But part of choosing that means that we've got to go and help other people decide to choose Jesus.

00:01:18.299 - 00:01:19.810

And that's the mission,

00:01:19.810 - 00:01:22.599

that we just keep multiplying each other.

00:01:22.650 - 00:01:23.549

Last week,

00:01:23.549 - 00:01:29.700

we talked about it from the direction of what happens when I run from the mission.

00:01:29.700 - 00:01:31.799

That there are going to be times in our lives,

00:01:31.799 - 00:01:35.400

there are going to be moments where I just decide,

00:01:35.400 - 00:01:39.299

"I don't want to do this". I've just made up my mind that this is too hard,

00:01:39.299 - 00:01:40.700

this is not what I want.

00:01:40.700 - 00:01:42.900

I want to be fortable,

00:01:42.900 - 00:01:44.099

my pride gets in the way,

00:01:44.099 - 00:01:45.100

all these different things.

00:01:45.100 - 00:01:46.670

And we just decide,

00:01:46.670 - 00:01:54.500

"I'm not going to do this for God". And how do we overe those things and how do we bat those things?

00:01:54.500 - 00:01:55.040

Well,

00:01:55.040 - 00:01:55.670

today,

00:01:55.670 - 00:02:00.099

we're going to talk about this idea of following God's lead.

00:02:00.099 - 00:02:01.079

And looking in Acts,

00:02:01.079 - 00:02:03.000

kind of chapters 15 and 16,

00:02:03.000 - 00:02:05.199

at this story of Paul.

00:02:05.199 - 00:02:10.099

And really look at it from the idea that sometimes I'm trying to live the mission.

00:02:10.099 - 00:02:13.599

Sometimes I'm trying to do what God has called me to do,

00:02:13.599 - 00:02:19.000

but I haven't quite really figured out what God's plete will is.

00:02:19.080 - 00:02:20.740

That I think I'm doing good,

00:02:20.740 - 00:02:22.199

I think I'm doing right,

00:02:22.199 - 00:02:29.300

but God's going to get Paul's attention because he's kind of in that moment where Paul's kind of doing what he thinks he's supposed to be doing.

00:02:29.300 - 00:02:29.719

God says,

00:02:29.719 - 00:02:29.939

"No,

00:02:29.939 - 00:02:30.120

no,

00:02:30.120 - 00:02:30.300

no,

00:02:30.300 - 00:02:30.479

no,

00:02:30.479 - 00:02:30.800

no.

00:02:30.800 - 00:02:33.800

I've got something else that I need you to do.

00:02:33.800 - 00:02:35.500

I've got other plans.

00:02:35.500 - 00:02:37.300

You're doing some good things,

00:02:37.300 - 00:02:42.050

but you're not doing what I want you to do at the moment". And so we're going to see,

00:02:42.050 - 00:02:43.500

how do we recognize those moments?

00:02:43.500 - 00:02:44.800

How do we get into those moments?

00:02:44.800 - 00:02:46.400

How do we live those moments?

00:02:46.469 - 00:02:48.460

Before we do,

00:02:48.460 - 00:02:52.500

let's go to God in prayer.

00:02:52.500 - 00:02:52.780

God,

00:02:52.780 - 00:02:56.099

we thank you so much for the chance to just be in your presence this morning.

00:02:56.099 - 00:03:01.300

We thank you for the opportunity to worship and to sing praises to you this morning.

00:03:01.300 - 00:03:10.429

We thank you for the chance that we had to gather around your table at your invitation to remember the death,

00:03:10.429 - 00:03:10.640

burial,

00:03:10.640 - 00:03:12.699

and resurrection of Jesus.

We thank you for this time that we've had today.

We pray now that as we open up to this time in the life of Paul,

00:03:19.900 - 00:03:22.599

that we will open up our hearts as well,

00:03:22.599 - 00:03:28.700

that we will be willing to listen to your words and to your encouragement,

00:03:28.700 - 00:03:30.210

to focus on your wants,

00:03:30.210 - 00:03:31.039

your needs,

00:03:31.039 - 00:03:31.420

God,

00:03:31.420 - 00:03:32.400

not our own.

00:03:32.400 - 00:03:44.900

We just pray that we continue to have a heart that is open to our munity and willing to reach out into our munity and bring people closer to you in the hopes that they will decide to bee children of yours.

00:03:44.999 - 00:03:45.120

God,

00:03:45.120 - 00:03:47.000

we pray that you just bless this time together.

00:03:47.000 - 00:03:48.699

It's in your son's name we pray.

00:03:48.699 - 00:03:50.300

Amen.

00:03:50.300 - 00:03:52.300

All right.

00:03:52.300 - 00:03:53.219

So this week,

00:03:53.219 - 00:03:55.300

Paul embracing his mission.

00:03:55.300 - 00:03:56.900

Let's kind of set the stage a little bit.

00:03:56.900 - 00:03:58.000

So Acts chapter 15,

00:03:58.000 - 00:03:58.999

we're not going to read all of this.

00:03:58.999 - 00:04:00.699

We're just going to kind of set the stage.

00:04:00.699 - 00:04:01.759

Acts chapter 15,

00:04:01.759 - 00:04:03.200

verses 1 through 19.

00:04:03.200 - 00:04:09.099

There had been this struggle within the church between Jewish Christians and non-Jewish Christians.

00:04:09.099 - 00:04:16.500

And what parts of the old law applied to new Christians who weren't Jews and what parts didn't?

00:04:16.500 - 00:04:22.500

The Jewish Christians really wanted to pick up the old law and just kind of keep living it.

00:04:22.500 - 00:04:24.600

And the new Christians are like,

00:04:24.600 - 00:04:25.029

"Well,

00:04:25.029 - 00:04:28.899

that's not us". And Paul's out there kind of dealing with this and having these issues.

00:04:28.899 - 00:04:29.879

And he's saying,

00:04:29.879 - 00:04:30.420

"Look,

00:04:30.420 - 00:04:31.300

the old is gone,

00:04:31.300 - 00:04:31.500

all right?

00:04:31.500 - 00:04:32.100

The old's gone.

00:04:32.100 - 00:04:43.000

We're not doing this anymore". And so all the apostles gather together in Jerusalem and they have this big conversation and they figure out a way to sort this out. 00:04:43.060 - 00:04:48.399

They figure out what the answer to this kind of first big church-wide problem is.

00:04:48.399 - 00:04:51.300

And once they make that decision,

00:04:51.300 - 00:04:55.199

I'm going to try to give you some ideas of where we are.

00:04:55.199 - 00:04:57.399

They're in Jerusalem right now having this meeting.

00:04:57.399 - 00:04:59.600

Once they make this decision,

00:04:59.600 - 00:05:04.399

then Paul and Barnabas and their kind of travel party set off to Antioch.

00:05:04.399 - 00:05:06.699

They go north,

00:05:06.699 - 00:05:09.899

And they start explaining to people what's going on,

00:05:09.899 - 00:05:10.600

what's happening,

00:05:10.600 - 00:05:13.100

what the answer is here.

00:05:13.100 - 00:05:16.000

This is how we're going to solve this problem.

00:05:16.000 - 00:05:18.399

Then in verses 36 through 41,

00:05:18.399 - 00:05:20.899

so we talked about during vacation Bible school,

00:05:20.899 - 00:05:24.199

we see the breakup of Paul and Barnabas.

00:05:24.199 - 00:05:26.600

Paul and Barnabas were going to,

00:05:26.600 - 00:05:28.199

they had a plan.

00:05:28.199 - 00:05:35.600

Their plan was to go back and visit all the churches that they had established in their first mission trip.

00:05:35.600 - 00:05:38.149

The plan was kind of okay,

00:05:38.149 - 00:05:40.199

but who was going was the issue.

00:05:40.319 - 00:05:42.399

Barnabas wanted to take John Mark,

00:05:42.399 - 00:05:43.399

and Paul says,

00:05:43.399 - 00:05:43.699

"No,

00:05:43.699 - 00:05:45.800

he was with us for a little while last time.

00:05:45.800 - 00:05:46.899

He's not ready for this.

00:05:46.899 - 00:05:48.399

He abandoned the mission.

00:05:48.399 - 00:05:48.910

You know,

00:05:48.910 - 00:05:50.000

he was not mitted.

00:05:50.000 - 00:05:51.139

And if you're going to do this,

00:05:51.139 - 00:05:56.699

you've got to be mitted". And so they kind of separate over this.

00:05:56.699 - 00:05:58.920

Paul takes Silas,

00:05:58.920 - 00:06:00.199

who's kind of with their group,

00:06:00.199 - 00:06:02.399
```

and John Mark and Barnabas,

00:06:02.399 - 00:06:07.000

they go off and they take off in two different directions.

00:06:07.000 - 00:06:08.800

So Barnabas is the red star.

00:06:08.800 - 00:06:12.199

He goes off and starts in one direction.

00:06:12.199 - 00:06:15.000

Paul continues up north,

00:06:15.000 - 00:06:17.600

and both of them are following the plan.

00:06:17.600 - 00:06:18.600 Their plan was,

00:06:18.600 - 00:06:19.399

"Let's go,

00:06:19.399 - 00:06:23.000

and let's go to the places that we've already been.

00:06:23.000 - 00:06:25.000

Let's go back and encourage these churches,

00:06:25.000 - 00:06:26.439

see how they're doing,

00:06:26.439 - 00:06:27.399

teach them,

00:06:27.399 - 00:06:29.199

and just kind of figure out where everybody is,

00:06:29.199 - 00:06:33.600

share this news that we have been given,

00:06:33.600 - 00:06:40.000

and just kind of keep working with them". So we have two groups going in two different directions.

00:06:40.000 - 00:06:43.799

As we get into the beginning of chapters 16,

00:06:43.799 - 00:06:46.600

we see Timothy joins the team.

00:06:46.600 - 00:06:50.680

They end up in kind of this area of Iconium,

00:06:50.680 - 00:06:51.319

Lystra,

00:06:51.319 - 00:06:52.000

and Derbe,

00:06:52.000 - 00:06:55.399

and they find Timothy.

00:06:55.399 - 00:06:59.000

Timothy is doing great things amongst the believers there.

00:06:59.000 - 00:07:00.199

So he picks him up.

00:07:00.199 - 00:07:02.600

He bees kind of Paul's new protege,

00:07:02.600 - 00:07:05.399

and they go on this trip together.

00:07:05.399 - 00:07:08.399

That leads us to our text this morning.

00:07:08.399 - 00:07:10.399

So let's start,

00:07:10.399 - 00:07:16.600

and let's read verses 6 through 15 together.

00:07:16.600 - 00:07:19.400

6 through 15 together.

00:07:19.400 - 00:07:25.000

"Paul and his panions traveled throughout the region of Pergaea and Galatia,

00:07:25.000 - 00:07:30.199

having been kept by the Holy Spirit from preaching the word in the province of Asa.

00:07:30.199 - 00:07:32.999

When they came to the border of Missa,

00:07:32.999 - 00:07:35.000

they tried to enter Bithynia,

00:07:35.000 - 00:07:39.800

but the Spirit of Jesus would not allow them to.

00:07:39.800 - 00:07:43.800

So they passed by Missa and down to Troas.

00:07:43.800 - 00:07:44.600

During the night,

00:07:44.600 - 00:07:48.600

Paul had a vision of a man of Macedonia standing and begging him,

00:07:48.600 - 00:07:53.000

'e over to Macedonia and help us.' After Paul had seen the vision,

00:07:53.000 - 00:07:57.399

he got ready at once to leave for Macedonia,

00:07:57.399 - 00:08:02.399

concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them". Let's start right there.

00:08:02.399 - 00:08:05.199

Let's just kind of start in that section.

00:08:05.199 - 00:08:07.800

Go back to our first point there.

00:08:07.800 - 00:08:13.199

The first idea here that we're going to talk about is we see the Spirit redirect.

00:08:13.199 - 00:08:15.000

We see the Spirit redirect.

00:08:15.000 - 00:08:16.999

So we start out here,

00:08:16.999 - 00:08:21.599

and they are getting ready to kind of go and do what they'd been planning to do.

00:08:21.599 - 00:08:22.800

Paul is kind of pumped,

00:08:22.800 - 00:08:23.600 I would imagine,

00:08:23.600 - 00:08:25.400 for this mission.

00:08:25.400 - 00:08:26.800

He's got his new team.

00:08:26.800 - 00:08:29.600

He's got Silas and Timothy that's part of him now.

00:08:29.600 - 00:08:31.009

He's got his purpose,

00:08:31.009 - 00:08:31.199 right?

00:08:31.199 - 00:08:39.399

His purpose is to go and check on the churches that they have established and to share this new message with them or this clarification of the gospel,

00:08:39.399 - 00:08:40.600

I guess you could say.

00:08:40.600 - 00:08:43.399

It's a new season of growth.

00:08:43.399 - 00:08:47.600

That is such a true kind of obvious thing of what's going on.

00:08:47.600 - 00:08:49.000

If you look in 16 verse 5,

00:08:49.000 - 00:08:57.799

"So the churches were strengthened in the faith and grew daily in number". It's an exciting time to be part of the mission.

00:08:57.799 - 00:08:59.200

And from the outside,

00:08:59.200 - 00:09:00.399

everything looked great,

00:09:00.399 - 00:09:01.000 right?

00:09:01.139 - 00:09:01.799 From the outside,

00:09:01.799 - 00:09:04.600

everything looked like this must be God's plan.

00:09:04.600 - 00:09:05.600

Everything's going well.

00:09:05.600 - 00:09:07.000

We're bringing on new teammates.

00:09:07.000 - 00:09:11.000

We've got this new mission that's kind of part of the overall mission.

00:09:11.000 - 00:09:15.799

Everything's going in a positive direction.

00:09:15.799 - 00:09:22.200

But even good plans aren't always God's plans.

00:09:22.200 - 00:09:23.600

Let that sink in for just a second.

00:09:23.600 - 00:09:28.000

Even good plans aren't always God's plans.

00:09:28.000 - 00:09:35.200

Paul seems to fall into this idea that we're going to retrace our steps.

00:09:35.200 - 00:09:38.600

We're gonna go where we have already been.

00:09:38.600 - 00:09:42.799

And I want you to think about what might be wrong with that for just a second.

00:09:42.799 - 00:09:44.240

It seems like a great idea,

00:09:44.240 - 00:09:44.799

right?

00:09:44.799 - 00:09:46.000

Let's go back where we've been.

00:09:46.000 - 00:09:47.600

Let's encourage these Christians.

00:09:47.600 - 00:09:50.799

Let's share this clarification with them.

00:09:50.799 - 00:09:55.200

But what is the overall mission that we talked about in the very first week?

00:09:55.240 - 00:09:59.200

Go into all the world.

00:09:59.200 - 00:10:05.399

Paul in 1 Corinthians is gonna make the claim that his job in this process is to plant.

00:10:05.399 - 00:10:11.399

His job is to go and share the Word really for the first time in all of these different places.

00:10:11.399 - 00:10:13.070

And in this situation,

00:10:13.070 - 00:10:14.200

he's not really doing that.

00:10:14.200 - 00:10:15.000

He's going,

00:10:15.000 - 00:10:21.200

"Go into all the places that I've already been before". And it's not that that was a bad thing.

00:10:21.200 - 00:10:23.000

It's not that it wasn't a good thing.

00:10:23.000 - 00:10:26.000

Was it a good thing to go back and encourage these Christians?

00:10:26.000 - 00:10:26.600

Yes,

00:10:26.600 - 00:10:28.200

absolutely.

00:10:28.200 - 00:10:32.600

But is that what Paul had been called to do?

00:10:32.600 - 00:10:36.399

He hadn't been called to go back and do this all over again.

00:10:36.399 - 00:10:41.000

He had been called to plant - to go into all the world.

00:10:41.000 - 00:10:45.000

And so as they are working through this process,

00:10:45.000 - 00:10:47.200

they get to certain places,

00:10:47.200 - 00:10:50.200

and the Holy Spirit says what?

00:10:50.200 - 00:10:52.000

I'm not letting you in there.

00:10:52.000 - 00:10:54.000

This is not where God needs you.

00:10:54.059 - 00:10:56.799

This is not what you are supposed to be about.

00:10:56.799 - 00:11:02.000

This is not the direction that we want you to go.

00:11:02.000 - 00:11:04.000

So when you think about that idea,

00:11:04.000 - 00:11:10.000

sometimes - this is just some things I thought about this week - sometimes God says no,

00:11:10.000 - 00:11:13.399

not because you're pletely off mission.

00:11:13.399 - 00:11:17.000

He doesn't say no because what you're doing is pletely wrong.

00:11:17.000 - 00:11:21.200

Sometimes He said no because He has something greater in mind.

00:11:21.200 - 00:11:22.799

He has something bigger in mind.

00:11:22.799 - 00:11:25.000

He has something better in mind.

00:11:25.000 - 00:11:25.710

You know,

00:11:25.710 - 00:11:27.000

my plan might be good,

00:11:27.000 - 00:11:29.600

but it also might keep me fortable.

00:11:29.600 - 00:11:30.799

My plan might be good,

00:11:30.799 - 00:11:33.399

but it also might keep me in control.

00:11:33.399 - 00:11:35.000

And my plan might be good,

00:11:35.000 - 00:11:40.600

but it might not truly acplish what God's trying to do through me.

00:11:40.600 - 00:11:44.600

We talked about this idea of fort and control and all this stuff last week.

00:11:44.600 - 00:11:49.200

That ended up causing Jonah to pletely run away.

00:11:49.200 - 00:11:50.600

But like we did mention,

00:11:50.659 - 00:11:55.000

sometimes we can hide from God right in the middle of a ministry.

00:11:55.000 - 00:11:57.000

We can get somewhere where I'm fortable,

00:11:57.000 - 00:11:58.399

what I'm doing seems good,

00:11:58.399 - 00:11:59.399

feels good,
00:11:59.399 - 00:12:00.799
looks good,
00:12:00.799 - 00:12:04.000
It seems to be acplishing good things.
00:12:04.000 - 00:12:06.019
But God might be ready to look at me and go,
00:12:06.019 - 00:12:06.320
hey,
00:12:06.320 - 00:12:07.600
you're ready for more.
00:12:07.600 - 00:12:10.200
You've grown enough where you are.
00:12:10.200 - 00:12:12.000
You've done good things where you are.
00:12:12.000 - 00:12:16.799
Now I need you to continue the mission somewhere else.
00:12:16.799 - 00:12:20.200
And I think that that's exactly what happens with Paul.
00:12:20.200 - 00:12:21.059
He's like,
00:12:21.059 - 00:12:21.399
look,
00:12:21.399 - 00:12:23.800
we don't need to retrace.
00:12:23.800 - 00:12:24.600
And if you look,
00:12:24.600 - 00:12:25.799
you really don't have any,
00:12:25.799 - 00:12:27.600
you don't have any conclusive evidence of this,
00:12:27.600 - 00:12:31.000
but if you look in the direction that Barnabas goes,
```

00:12:31.000 - 00:12:40.599

it's almost like they're going to eventually circle back up and meet each other if they go about the same plan and go to the same places that they've been.

00:12:40.599 - 00:12:41.799

They're eventually,

00:12:41.799 - 00:12:44.200

Barnabas just basically turns left.

00:12:44.200 - 00:12:47.399

Paul heads north for a little while and then turns back left.

00:12:47.399 - 00:12:50.399

But eventually they're going to reconnect with each other.

00:12:50.399 - 00:12:53.200

So I'm going to assume,

00:12:53.200 - 00:12:59.600

my thought on this process here is that Barnabas continues the original plan.

00:12:59.600 - 00:13:01.800

He goes back and he encourages.

00:13:01.800 - 00:13:02.799

That's what he's known as,

00:13:02.799 - 00:13:03.200

right?

00:13:03.200 - 00:13:04.399

The son of encouragement.

00:13:04.399 - 00:13:07.800

He goes back and encourages these churches.

00:13:07.800 - 00:13:08.600

And God says,

00:13:08.600 - 00:13:09.200

but now Paul,

00:13:09.200 - 00:13:11.200

I need you to do what we were originally going to do.

00:13:11.200 - 00:13:16.399

And we need to go and continue to plant and go into these new places.

00:13:16.399 - 00:13:19.800

So we have this vision that es from God.

00:13:19.800 - 00:13:23.200

The vision es when he begins to what?

00:13:23.200 - 00:13:24.000

Listen,

00:13:24.000 - 00:13:29.799

God often gives us clarity when we step away from the rush of life.

00:13:29.799 - 00:13:32.199

When I think about what Paul's doing.

00:13:32.199 - 00:13:34.200

I think about the excitement of it all.

00:13:34.200 - 00:13:35.600

Meeting new people.

00:13:35.600 - 00:13:36.799

Getting to teach.

00:13:36.799 - 00:13:37.299

And he did,

00:13:37.299 - 00:13:37.850

I'm sure,

00:13:37.850 - 00:13:40.000

teach new people along the way.

00:13:40.000 - 00:13:45.000

Getting to introduce a new brother into the ministry in  $\ensuremath{\operatorname{Timothy}}$  .

00:13:45.000 - 00:13:46.399

Going to all these places.

00:13:46.399 - 00:13:49.000

The rush of ministry.

00:13:49.000 - 00:13:51.200

The busyness of what he was doing.

00:13:51.200 - 00:13:53.600

You look at the life of Paul,

00:13:53.600 - 00:13:55.399

and except when he's in prison,

00:13:55.399 - 00:13:56.400

and even then,

00:13:56.400 - 00:13:59.799

you don't get the idea that he slowed down much.

00:13:59.799 - 00:14:00.800

He kept going.

00:14:00.800 - 00:14:01.600

He kept pushing.

00:14:01.600 - 00:14:04.600

He kept doing what he felt like he was supposed to be doing.

00:14:04.600 - 00:14:07.399

And sometimes when we're in the middle of that,

00:14:07.399 - 00:14:11.799

we lose our connection to listening to God.

00:14:11.799 - 00:14:12.810

Because again,

00:14:12.810 - 00:14:14.599

what I'm doing seems good.

00:14:14.680 - 00:14:17.799

What I'm doing seems like it's producing good things.

00:14:17.799 - 00:14:20.399

And so Paul keeps trying to do these good things,

00:14:20.399 - 00:14:24.200

and God just shuts everything down.

00:14:24.200 - 00:14:26.599

He just shuts everything down so that,

00:14:26.599 - 00:14:28.020 hopefully,

00:14:28.020 - 00:14:29.200 I believe,

00:14:29.200 - 00:14:33.799

that Paul will listen to him.

00:14:33.799 - 00:14:36.399

I also want you to think about this.

00:14:36.399 - 00:14:38.800

When we e into these moments,

00:14:38.800 - 00:14:40.200 and the doors close,

00:14:40.200 - 00:14:42.600

especially when we're in ministry,

00:14:42.779 - 00:14:46.200

and the doors may have a great idea.

00:14:46.200 - 00:14:47.399

You may have a great direction.
