- ¹⁹ then will you delight in right sacrifices, in burnt offerings and whole burnt offerings; then bulls will be offered on your altar.



Would You Like This? I 3 STEPS

- 1) STEP#1: Acknowledge Your Sin to 0
 - 1. That you are in need of Os Mercy 57:1

 If You aren't trying to justify yourself
 If You can't cleanse yourself
 - 2. That your sin is against the Holy & [=] David's adultery + murder against & What?

This is how it works. You can't break Ind Table of Law without breaking 1st []

Second, sinning against people is always sin against & who made them + loves them! Like Damaging Artwork is violation of Artist

3. That you have not only sinned but are a Sinner 51:5-6

Have you told the truth about yourself to 6?

2) STEP #Z: Asking O for Forgiveness

Have Mercy on me, 0 God (51:1)

Blot out my transgressions (1)

Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity (2)

Cleanse me from my sin (Z)

Purge me w. hyssop, and I shall be clean (7)

I'M Wash me and I shall be whiter than snow (7)

Let me hear joy + gladness, let the bones you have broken rejoice (8)

Qs... Ask You

Do you see the position this puts you in? = Powerless, at Os Mercy! Men's Prayer

IP Do you see the position this puts 0 in?

= He must bear the Cost of FORGIVENESS

And He Does Jesus, Son of David

Absorbs its Judgment, Forgives us

3) STEP #3: Accept Os Forgiveness
ON Os Terms ! Not Your Own!
Why should I? What is the result?

- 1. You will lead other sinners to joy of forgiveness (13)
- 2. You will sing of Os righteousness and declare His praise (14-15)
- 3. You will have the broken + contrite heart & delights in (17) Dismas
- 4. You will be a Leader in Church Renewal + Growth (18-19)

- 1. What are some of the "Watershed" differences between the state of unforgiveness and the state of forgiveness the Christian lives in? Discuss from Psalm 51.
 - a. you defend and justify self vs. having a broken and contrite heart
 - b. you hide, minimize, excuse, rationalize and atone for your sin vs. the joy of having your sin washed and whiter than snow by God's forgiveness.
 - c. you don't tell others of your guilt and God's forgiveness vs. you tell others of and praise God for his amazing forgiveness?
 - d. you don't forgive others and hold grudges vs. freely and fully forgiving others as you have been forgiven.
- 2. What does Psalm 51 teach you about the three steps of receiving God's forgiveness: (1) Acknowledge your Sin to God (51:1-6), (2) Asking God for Forgiveness (51:1, 7-12), and (3) Accepting God's Forgiveness on God's terms, that is, through the atoning work of Jesus Christ (as a beggar in need of God's mercy).
- 3. What are the marks of one who is forgiven that we see in Psalm 51:14-19. Which of these marks would you like to have more in your life? Pray for each other.
