# 1) It Matters Objectively

Preveals + represents & God is his Name

It is being profoned by priests/peoples offering (6-10)

Why does & care so much about His Name, Glory? = Because it is objectively the most valuable thing

Why should I care?

2) It Matters Subjectively

[=] Malachi = Encounter w. O... Out of 55 verses, 47 record the first person address of the LORD... "presents a vivid encounter between O and the people unsurpassed in the prophetic books."

Peter Verhoff

Put 2 WAYS ... Profaning As Name

1 Damages Destroys Os Relationship w. You

Ex. 20:7 "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain." Westminster Larger Catechian

See? D is Angry, hurt, aggrived ... just like you are when people dishonor you

2 Damages > Destroys You ... You , mind, soul, body made for O + god's glory "The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous man runs into it and is & safe." Prov 18:10

Why should I care?

= Apart from knowing, fearing, treasuring, sheltering, glorifying the Name of the LORDY You are in a house on fire ... burning

BIG PROBLEM! Continue to Profane LORDS Name

(3) It Matters Prophetically

= = Messianic Prophecy 1:10, Cf. 4:1-5, esp. vs. Z Fulfilled in Jesus Christ and His gospel that has converted multitude from the nations

This explains LORD Os care + concern for right sacrifices = reveal + reflect Sacrifice of Jesus Christ who became our profaning Os name + gives us his honor of Os Name Jesus' Chief End = Os Name

This is where History is going ... Global Worship Who could have imagined? 3:16-18 + Today

Heard? "Be on the right side of history"

Vast Multitude Worshipping Of at Wedding Feast of Son
