(3) Appeal #2: Love one another

[=] Context of "idlers" + over-realized eschatology > calls them to the hard + high ethic of love

Aside: Christian sexual holiness + love ethic not opposed or contradicting. Today "love" = sexual permissiveness: Debate is over what love is; We can't for a minute cut tie between sexual holiness + love.

- 1. "Now concerning brotherly love you have no need for anyone to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by O to love one another"
 - = 6 Himself, by the Holy Spirit, teaches, even propels Christians to love one another Cs. 4:8 Romans 5:5
- 2. "for that is indeed what you are doing ... = love for other Christians is mark of true faith /H.S.
- 3. "But we urge you brothers, to do this more + more" = We are called to grow in earnest, accurate, committed love.

* Cannot love w/o commitment + presence in community Balanced

- 1. "Ask + urge you in the LORD Jesus"... for you know what instructions we gave you through the LORD Jesus" = Jesus' Gospel + Jesus' ethic can't be separated "Jesus bled for your holiness"
- 2. "that you received from us how you ought to walk and to please 0." = There is a Xtian moral standard/ path ("will of 0") and motivation which will be in contrast w. culture + religions
- 3. "just as you are doing, that you do so more + more"

 = By definitions, Christians are walking this path and
 are called to continual growth b/c & holiness is infinite

- 4. "Now may our O + Father himself, and our LORD Jesus ... make you increase + abound in love for one another and for all ... establish your hearts blameless in holiness.

 = O's mighty grace past, present + future is the foundation for Xtian ethics.

 O Paul's Prayer 3:11-13 > ethical appeal 4:1ff

 Christian hope of return of Jesus frames

- 2 Appeal #1: Sexual holiness
 - 1. It is Os will that you be sanctified, sexually holy O created sex. Good gift. But b/c sin, broken, distorted, idolized Thessalonica ... Today ... Conversation w. Jacob
 - 2. That you abstain from sexual immorality, lit. "cut/break" ... examples
 - 3. That you his own vessel in holiness + honour."

 interpretation 1 = Know how to control his body
 interpretation 2 = take a wife for himself Stott
 Conversation w. Jacob ... 1 Cor 7:8
 - 4. That having a holy fear of θ , you would respect θ 's boundaries holiness + honour vs. passion of lust
 - >> Jesus comes between you + other person and is an "akenger in all these things" (vs. 6)
 - 5. That in great regard to 0, and w. the help of the Holy Spirit you will earnestly step into your calling to holiness, specifically sexual holiness

INTENSE! HARD! DEFEATED! ASHAMED! ... "ask"

- I Everyone is sexually broken
- IT Jesus redeemed every part of you + gave you Mighty Spirit, have hope
- I "more + more" ... take baby steps
