① THE LESSON OF CLEAN + UNCLEAN

1. The Holiness of Θ is the basis of the clean + unclean laws "*Consecrate yourselves therefore and be holy, for I am holy.*" *11:44-45*
2. Clean + unclean laws were made to consecrate Israel as Θ 's holy people so that LORD Θ could dwell in their midst. "*Thus you shall keep the people of Israel separate from their uncleanness, lest they die in their uncleanness by defiling my tabernacle that is in their midst*" *15:21*
3. Priests were essential in cleansing process

4. Daily discerning one's status as clean/unclean

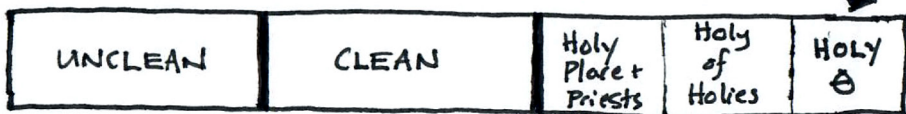
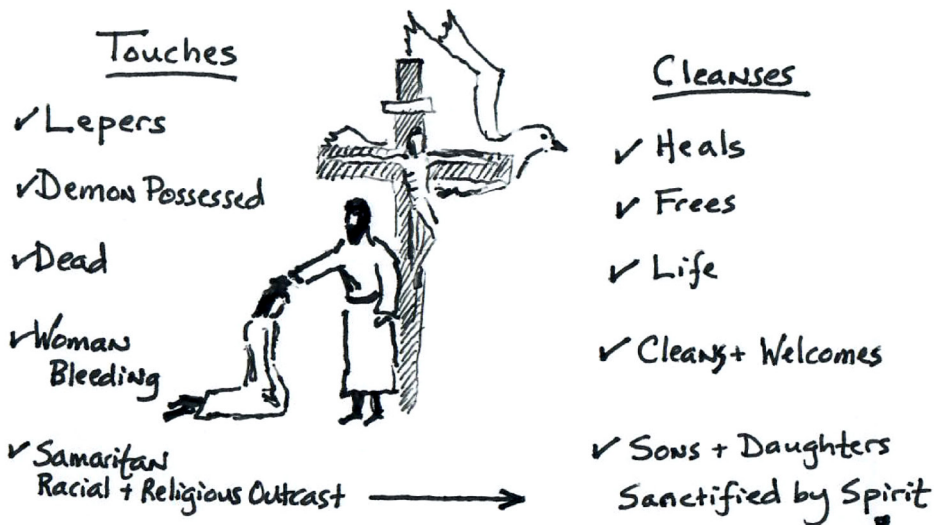

- Cleansing was provided to become clean.

atonement sacrifice [Mary], Sacrifices for cleansing
lepers, those w. bodily discharges. And priests

into community.
- Though Θ 's law confronts Covenant Community

religious community as "unclean" **Matthew 15:10**,
