## Isaiah 43

**43** But now thus says the Lord,

and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm

 or honored me with your sacrifices.  
 I have not burdened you with offerings,  
 or wearied you with frankincense.  
<sup>24</sup> You have not bought me sweet cane with money,  
 or satisfied me with the fat of your sacrifices.  
 But you have burdened me with your sins;  
 you have wearied me with your iniquities.  
<sup>25</sup> “I, I am he  
 who blots out your transgressions for my own sake,  
 and I will not remember your sins.  
<sup>26</sup> Put me in remembrance; let us argue together;  
 set forth your case, that you may be proved right.  
<sup>27</sup> Your first father sinned,  
 and your mediators transgressed against me.  
<sup>28</sup> Therefore I will profane the princes of the sanctuary,  
 and deliver Jacob to utter destruction  
 and Israel to reviling.

### Behold Your God: The Savior

⚔️ is **Savior**... But make sure you have   
 Version both 🖱️ Thrilling + 🖱️ Troubling  
 ➡️ Requires deconstruction of false beliefs  
**Not this, but this ... Ready?**



## ① Not salvation from trouble but salvation thru trouble

False Belief = Salvation gives me a kind of force field or vaccine to shield me from trouble

☰☷ Notice ...

- ☑ Context is  $\Theta$ 's Judgment of his people **Isaiah**
- ☑ Covenantal Language  $\rightarrow$   $\Theta$  promises covenant-keeping intimacy, presence **43:1-2**
- ☑  $\Theta$ 's promises are to be w. us, help, strengthened through trouble **waters/rivers, fire/flames**
- ☑  $\Theta$ 's gathering of his sons + daughters **2nd Exodus** is from exile (= suffering) **vs 3-7**

Your experience, right?

- ➔➔➔ Salvation is based in  $\Theta$ 's covenantal Being **43:3**  
And for  $\Theta$ 's glory **vs.7** It is Not about You!  
↺ See how thrilling and troubling?

## ② $\Theta$ is not a savior BUT THE SAVIOR

False Belief = many gods, many "salvations"  
Moderns find ☰☷ exclusivity troubling

☰☷ "Courtroom Drama" w.  $\Theta$  presiding judge, Isaiah as court reporter + witnesses "blind" + "deaf" + Nations + Israel You are invited as well to listen to  $\Theta$ 's case + do "comparitive religions" **vs 9**

1. Whose gods can declare this, and show us the former things [Exodus or New Exodus] = Fact of the Revelation  $\rightarrow$  Redemption of  $\Theta$ !
2. Before me no god was formed, nor shall there be any after me. I, I am the LORD, and besides me there is no Savior = Argument of the Being, the self-existence of  $\Theta$

3. ... I am he; there is none who can deliver from my hand; I work, and who can turn it back?  
= Case of the sovereign power of  $\Theta$

Wait! These are just self-referential claims. You can't do that! No, rather, the Mighty Acts of  $\Theta$  played out in History **2nd Exodus/Cyrus**  
This creates an existential crisis of decision for you. You are all in or all out!

③ Not just a Savior in heaven BUT a Savior in history

False Belief = Salvation is fire insurance from Hell  
Aunt Margaret "Mom I want you to be saved"

1. The LORD is going to do a new thing in History **43:14ff** Redemption from Babylon "A new exodus"

2. LORD  $\Theta$  will enter History **Jesus Christ** and accomplish the Ultimate Redemption  
**Exodus from slavery to Sin, Satan, Death**

➡  $\Theta$ 's Deliverance in History is very Personal! Not done thru an agency, program but **I will**

**Apply** The Savior  $\Theta$ 's salvation in history doesn't absolve you of accountability but calls you into a whole new life of faith, trust... **Doc #1**

Are you calling upon  $\Theta$  in prayer or are you weary of  $\Theta$ ? **vs. 22 Doc #2**

Are you honoring  $\Theta$  by praise + offering your body as a living sacrifice or burdening  $\Theta$  with your sins? **vs 23-24 Doc #3**

MAKE MUCH OF  $\Theta$  YOUR SAVIOR
