**Christian** = Mandate is for you... to do

**Non-Christian** = Mandate is for you... to receive

Covid/Vaccine Mandates By contrast, Jesus authority is grounded in his love for his disciples/you! ✝

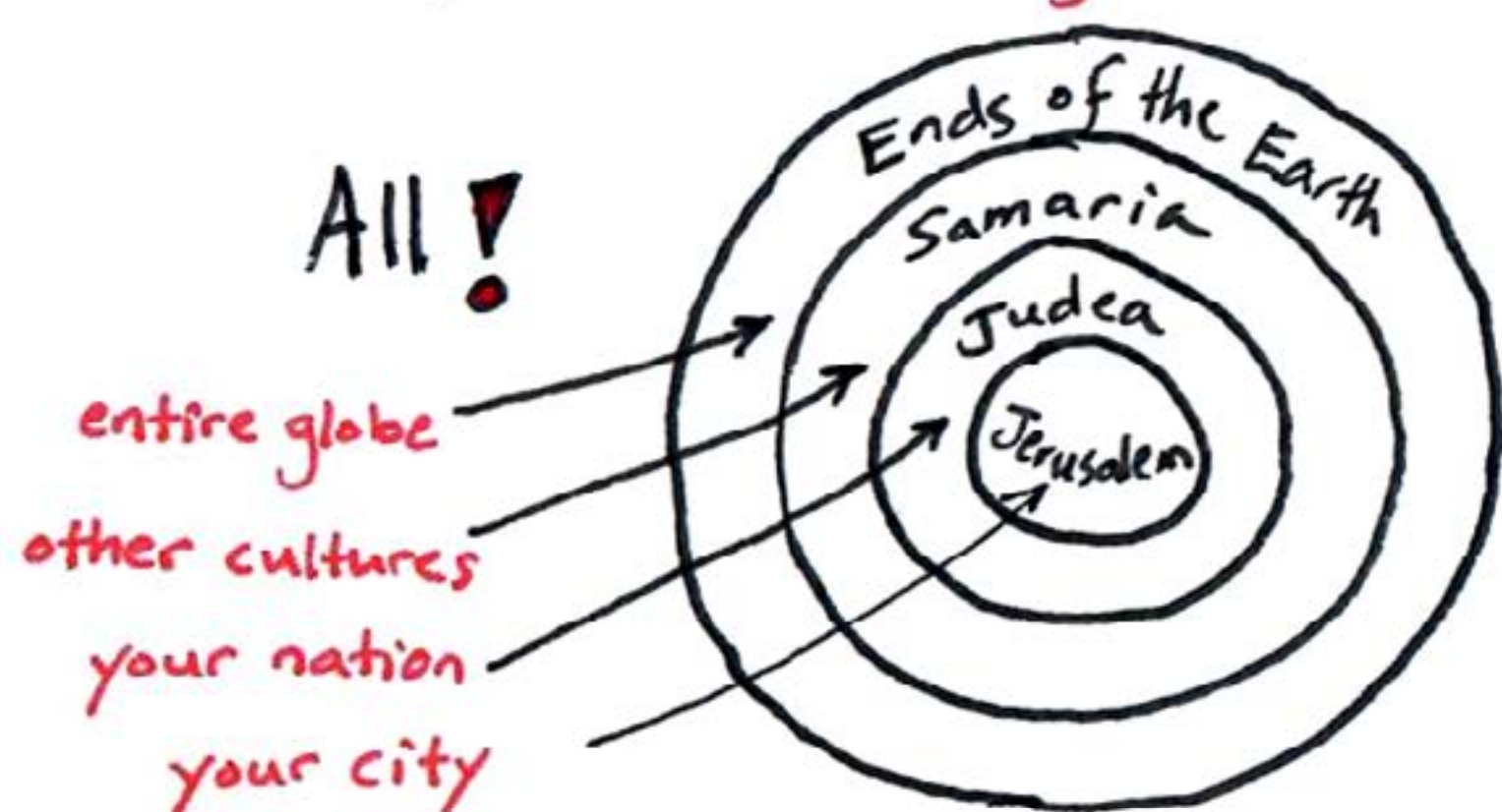
