→ We must recover/practice Lament!

① What Lament is

1. Lament about God's perceived absence, forgetfulness, even purposeful abandonment

"How long, O LORD? Will you forget me forever? How long will you hide your face from me?" vs. 1

2. Lament about the agony of your heart, suffering/struggle of soul, your despair

"How long must I take counsel in my soul, and have sorrow in my heart all the day?" vs. 2

3. Lament about your enemies "haters"

"How long shall my enemy be exalted over me?" vs. 2

Lament? Pouring out your ❤️ to God;
Processing your troubles w. God; Questioning
railing against, even accusing Θ; Asking Θ
for help, action "Consider and answer me,
O LORD my God; light up my eyes, lest I
sleep the sleep of death, lest my enemy say,
'I have prevailed over him,' lest my foes rejoice
because I am shaken."

Not professional counseling, prayer to Θ

Not stuffing ❤️, emotions, processing

Why don't we do it? Pray laments?

② Why laments are so hard... **3 REASONS**

1 BAD DICHOTOMY between what we
evaluate as "spiritual" and not

Spiritual = Psalm 8 Wonder + Awe at God's
glory + grace, care and mindfulness

Unspiritual = Psalm 13... "How long" 4x

But both by King David "Man after God's heart"
and to choirmaster for public worship!

2 BAD THEOLOGY because lament is based in God's covenant love

"But I have trusted in your steadfast love;
my heart shall rejoice in your salvation"

covenant = Sovereign God's bond of blood,
unbreakable + irrevocable

"Future Grace" Piper

Proven once + for all in Jesus Romans 8:3

3 BAD SELF-PITY it is so easy to sink into self pity in experience of God's abandonment, in inner sadness + turmoil of your soul + attack of your enemy Right?

→ CALL YOU TO LAMENT THIS WEEK

Make decision! "but"

Cry out to the LORD your God "O LORD, My God"

Cast yourself on LORD's steadfast love... kids

Pour out your heart to Him Brad... Mark

Wait in anticipation for Future Grace
"My heart shall rejoice in your salvation"

Sing in Faith that God will deal
