    See, early Christians were "all in." It was

  - 2. In light of the riches of ancient Jewish culture that Christians gave up

    Apostle Paul, 3:3ff > Israel today... "all in"
  - 3. In light of the mighty Roman Empire Rodney Stark

Paul's words captured s and still do today!

What was the power of this moral journey + maximal commitment that has won the day?
